I. BY HIS SIGNS, WONDERS, AND MIRALES, CREDENTIALS

- A. God Did Signs And Wonders On Egypt Through His Servant Moses, Deut. 6:22; 18:15, 18, 19
- B. Jesus Did Miracles, Signs And Wonders Far Greater Than Moses, Acts 2:22
- C. Jesus Gave His Apostles Authority To Do Signs, And Wonders, Acts 2:43; 5:12

II. BY HIS VERBAL CLAIMS

- A. He Clearly Told Israel He Was God’s Son, Jn. 5:17, 18
- B. He Clearly Told Israel That He Had Come Down From Heaven, Jn. 6:38
- C. He Clearly Told Israel That He Was Their Only Hope, Jn. 8:24

III. BY HIS PRESENTATION AS GOD’S PROMISED KING

- A. God Fulfilled Prophecy Of Him, Zech. 9:9; Mt. 21:5
- B. He Accepted The People’s Acclaim, Mt. 21:6-9; John 12:16
- C. He Rebuked The Religious Leaders In Their Attempt To Stop The People’s Praise, Luke 19:37-40

IV. BY HIS REVEALING OF HIS EMOTIONS OVER THE NATION THROUGH HIS SON

- A. Christ Wept Over The Doomed City, Lk. 19:41,42
- B. Christ Pronounced God’s Judgment On The City, Lk. 19:43, 44

V. BY HIS SUBSTITUTIONARY DEATH FOR US

- A. Isaiah Predicted His Death And Suffering, Isa. 53
 - 1. Israel would resist the report, Isa. 53:1
 - 2. They would think God was judging Him, v4
 - 3. He was crucified for us, v-5, 6, 8, 10-12

B. He Himself Predicted His Death For Us, Mt. 20:28;

C. John The Baptist Predicted His Death

- 1. John was the Forerunner of the Savior,
 - a. Identified at his birth as such, Lk. 1:76;
 - b. Plainly confessed by himself, Jn. 1:19-23
- 2. John pointed Him out as the Savior, Jn. 1:29, 33-36

D. God fulfilled His Death For Us, Acts 2:22, 23

--The Nation’s greatest sin ever!

- 1. God allowed the False Trials, Mt. 26:59, 60, 63-68
 - 2. God allowed Governor Pilate To Give Him Over For Crucifixion, Mk. 15:9-15;
 - 3. God allowed Rome to Mock And Crucify His Beloved Son For Us,
 - a. The Gentiles Mocked Him, Jn. 19:2,3
 - b. The Gentiles nailed him to the cross, Mt. 27:31, 33-35;
 - c. The People and the Jewish Leaders Mocked Him, Mt. 27:39-43
 - d. God allowed some of the Nation to Repent, Acts 2:36-41
- The Remnant, Rom. 9:27; 11:5
