Sermon Scriptures

<u>Isa. 53:1</u> ¶ Who has believed our message? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?

<u>Isa. 53:4</u> ¶ Surely our griefs He Himself bore, And our sorrows He carried; Yet we ourselves esteemed Him stricken, Smitten of God, and afflicted.

Isa. 53:5 But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; The chastening for our well-being *fell* upon Him, And by His scourging we are healed.

<u>Is. 53:6</u> All of us like sheep have gone astray, Each of us has turned to his own way; But **the LORD has caused the iniquity of us all To fall on Him.**

<u>Isa. 53:8</u> By oppression and judgment He was taken away; And as for His generation, who considered That He was cut off out of the land of the living For **the transgression of my people, to whom the stroke** *was due?*

Isa. 53:10-12 10 ¶ But the LORD was pleased To crush Him, putting *Him* to grief; If He would **render Himself** *as* **a guilt offering**, He will see *His* offspring, He will prolong *His* days, And the good pleasure of the LORD will prosper in His hand. **11** As a result of the anguish of His soul, He will see *it and* be satisfied; By His knowledge the Righteous One, My Servant, **will justify the many, As He will bear their iniquities. 12** Therefore, I will allot Him a portion with the great, And He will divide the booty with the strong; Because **He poured out Himself to death**, And was numbered with the transgressors; **Yet He Himself bore the sin of many, And interceded for the transgressors.**

Matt. 20:28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

Luke 1:76 "And you, child, will be called the prophet of the Most High; For you will go on BEFORE THE LORD TO PREPARE HIS WAYS;

John 1:19-23 19 ¶ This is the testimony of John, when the Jews sent to him priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, "Who are you?" 20 And he confessed and did not deny, but confessed, "I am not the Christ." 21 They asked him, "What then? Are you Elijah?" And he said, "I am not." "Are you the Prophet?" And he answered, "No." 22 Then they said to him, "Who are you, so that we may give an answer to those who sent us? What do you say about yourself?" 23 He said, "I am A VOICE OF ONE CRYING IN THE WILDERNESS, 'MAKE STRAIGHT THE WAY OF THE LORD,' as Isaiah the prophet said." John 1:29 ¶ The next day he saw Jesus coming to him and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!

<u>John 1:33-36</u> <u>33</u> "I did not recognize Him, but He who sent me to baptize in water said to me, 'He upon whom you see the Spirit descending and remaining upon Him, this is the One who baptizes in the Holy Spirit.' <u>34</u> "I myself have seen, and have testified that this is the Son of God." <u>35</u> ¶ Again the next day John was standing with two of his disciples, <u>36</u> and he looked at Jesus as He walked, and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God!"

<u>Acts 2:22, 23</u> 22 ¶ "Men of Israel, listen to these words: Jesus the Nazarene, a man attested to you by God with miracles and wonders and signs which God performed through Him in your midst, just as you yourselves know — 23 this *Man*, **delivered over by the predetermined plan and foreknowledge of God**, you nailed to a cross by the hands of godless men and put *Him* to death.

<u>Matt. 26:59, 60</u> <u>59</u> Now the chief priests and the whole Council kept trying to **obtain false testimony against Jesus**, so that they might put Him to death. <u>60</u> They did not find *any*, even though **many false witnesses came forward**. But later on two came forward,

Matt. 26:63-68 63 But Jesus kept silent. And the high priest said to Him, "I adjure You by the living God, that You tell us whether You are the Christ, the Son of God." <u>64</u> Jesus said to him, "You have said it *yourself*; nevertheless I tell you, hereafter you will see THE SON OF MAN SITTING AT THE RIGHT HAND OF POWER, and COMING ON THE CLOUDS OF HEAVEN." <u>65</u> ¶ Then the high priest tore his robes and said, "He has blasphemed! What further need do we have of witnesses? Behold, you have now heard the blasphemy; <u>66</u> what do you think?" They answered, "He deserves death!" <u>67</u> ¶ Then they spat in His face and beat Him with their fists; and others slapped Him, <u>68</u> and said, "Prophesy to us, You Christ; who is the one who hit You?"

<u>Mark 15:9-15</u> 9 Pilate answered them, saying, "Do you want me to release for you the King of the Jews?" <u>10</u> For **he was aware that** the chief priests had handed Him over **because of envy**. <u>11</u> But the chief priests stirred up the crowd *to ask* him to release Barabbas for them instead. <u>12</u> Answering again, Pilate said to them, "Then what shall I do with Him whom you call the King of the Jews?" <u>13</u> They shouted back, "Crucify Him!" <u>14</u> But Pilate said to them, "Why, what evil has He done?" But they shouted all the more, "Crucify Him!" <u>15</u> Wishing to satisfy the crowd, Pilate released Barabbas for them, and after having Jesus scourged, he handed Him over to be crucified.

<u>John 19:2, 3</u> And the soldiers twisted together **a crown of thorns** and put it on His head, and put **a purple robe** on Him;

John 19:3 and they *began* to come up to Him and say, "Hail, King of the Jews!" and to give Him slaps *in the face*.

<u>Matt. 27:31</u> After they had mocked Him, they took the *scarlet* robe off Him and put His *own* garments back on Him, and **led Him away to crucify Him.**

Matt. 27:33-3533 \P And when they came to a place called Golgotha, which meansPlace of a Skull,34they gave Him wine to drink mixed with gall; and after tasting*it*, He was unwilling to drink.35 \P And when they had crucified Him, they divided upHis garments among themselves by casting lots.

Matt. 27:39-43 39 And those passing by were hurling abuse at Him, wagging their heads <u>40</u> and saying, "You who *are going to* destroy the temple and rebuild it in three days, save Yourself! If You are the Son of God, come down from the cross." <u>41</u> In the same way the chief priests also, along with the scribes and elders, were mocking *Him* and saying, <u>42</u> "He saved others; He cannot save Himself. He is the King of Israel; let Him now come down from the cross, and we will believe in Him. <u>43</u> "HE TRUSTS IN GOD; LET GOD RESCUE *Him* now, IF HE DELIGHTS IN HIM; for He said, 'I am the Son of God.""

<u>Acts 2:36-41</u> <u>36</u> ¶ "Therefore let **all the house of Israel** know for certain that God has made Him both Lord and Christ — **this Jesus whom you crucified**." <u>37</u> ¶ Now when they heard *this*, **they were pierced to the heart**, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brethren, **what shall we do?**" <u>38</u> Peter *said* to them, "**Repent**, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. <u>39</u> "For the promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off, **as many as the Lord our God will call to Himself**." <u>40</u> And with many other words he solemnly testified and kept on exhorting them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation!" <u>41</u> So then, those who had received his word were baptized; and **that day there were added about three thousand souls**.

<u>**Rom. 9:27</u>** ¶ Isaiah cries out concerning Israel, "THOUGH THE NUMBER OF THE SONS OF ISRAEL BE LIKE THE SAND OF THE SEA, **IT IS THE REMNANT THAT WILL BE SAVED;**</u>

<u>Rom. 11:5</u> In the same way then, there has also come to be at the present time a remnant according to *God's* gracious choice.
