<u>Rev. 20:3b, 7</u> <u>3b</u> and he threw him into the abyss, and shut *it* and sealed *it* over him, so that he would not deceive the nations any longer, **until the thousand years were completed; after these things he must be released for a short time.** 

 $\underline{7}$  ¶ When the thousand years are completed, **Satan will be released from his prison**,

<u>Rev. 20:8a</u> and will come out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together for the war; the number of them is like the sand of the seashore.

**Rev. 20:9** And they came up on the broad plain of the earth and **surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city**, and fire came down from heaven and devoured them.

<u>Isa. 11:9</u> They will not hurt or destroy in all My holy mountain, For the earth will be full of the knowledge of the LORD As the waters cover the sea.

<u>Jer. 31:33, 34</u> "But this is **the covenant** which I will make with the house of Israel after those days," declares the LORD, "I will **put My law within them and on their heart** I will write it; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people.

<u>34</u> "They **will not teach again, each man** his neighbor and each man his brother, **saying,** 'Know the LORD,' for they will all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them," declares the LORD, "for I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more."

**Rev. 20:9b** And they came up on the broad plain of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city, and fire came down from heaven and devoured them.

## God's use of fire for judgment in the Old Testament

<u>Lev. 10:1, 2</u> ¶ Now Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, took their respective firepans, and after putting fire in them, placed incense on it and offered strange fire before the LORD, which He had not commanded them. 2 And fire came out from the presence of the LORD and consumed them, and they died before the LORD.

Num. 16:35 Fire also came forth from the LORD and consumed the two hundred and fifty men who were offering the incense. (Korah's rebellion against Moses)

**Deut. 4:24** "For the **LORD your God is a consuming fire**, a jealous God.

<u>Rev. 20:10</u> And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are also; and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

**Heb. 9:27** And inasmuch as it is appointed for men to die once and after this *comes* judgment,

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<u>Isa. 53:6</u> All of us like sheep have gone astray, Each of us has turned to his own way; But the LORD has caused the iniquity of us all To fall on Him.

<u>Rom. 5:8</u> But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

<u>2 Cor. 5:10</u> For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may be recompensed for his deeds in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.

**Rom. 14:10** ¶ But you, why do you judge your brother? Or you again, why do you regard your brother with contempt? **For we will all stand before the judgment seat of God.** 

<u>1 Cor. 3:10-15</u> <u>10</u> ¶ According to the grace of God which was given to me, like a wise master builder I laid a foundation, and another is building on it. **But each man must be careful how he builds on it.** <u>11</u> For no man can lay a foundation other than the one which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. <u>12</u> Now if any man builds on the foundation with **gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw,** <u>13</u> each man's work will **become evident;** for the day will show it because it is *to be* revealed with fire, and **the fire itself will test the quality** of each man's work. <u>14</u> If any man's work which he has built on **it remains, he will receive a reward**. <u>15</u> If any man's **work is burned up, he will suffer loss**; but he **himself will be saved**, yet so as through fire.
