Sunday, May 3, 2020 Sermon Scriptures

<u>Matt. 25:31-34, 41, 46</u> <u>31</u> ¶ "But when the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, then **He will sit on His glorious throne**. <u>32</u> "All **the nations** will be gathered before Him; and He will separate them from one another, as the shepherd separates the sheep from the goats; <u>33</u> and He will put the **sheep on His right, and the goats on the left**. <u>34</u> ¶ "Then the King will say to those on His right, 'Come, you who are blessed of My Father, **inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world**. <u>41</u> ¶ "Then He will also say to **those on His left**, **'Depart from Me**, accursed ones, into **the eternal fire** which has been prepared for the devil and his angels; <u>46</u> "These will **go away into eternal punishment**, but **the righteous into eternal life**."

<u>Zech. 12:10</u> ¶ "I will pour out on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the Spirit of grace and of supplication, so that they will look on Me whom they have pierced; and they will mourn for Him, as one mourns for an only son, and they will weep bitterly over Him like the bitter weeping over a firstborn.

Ezek. 20:33-38 33 ¶ "As I live," declares the Lord GOD, "surely with a mighty hand and with an outstretched arm and with wrath poured out, I shall be king over you. 34 "I will bring you out from the peoples and gather you from the lands where you are scattered, with a mighty hand and with an outstretched arm and with wrath poured out; 35 and I will bring you into the wilderness of the peoples, and there I will enter into **36** "As I entered into judgment with your fathers in judgment with you face to face. the wilderness of the land of Egypt, so I will enter into judgment with you," declares the Lord GOD. 37 "I will make you pass under the rod, and I will bring you into the 38 and I will purge from you the rebels and those who bond of the covenant; transgress against Me; I will bring them out of the land where they sojourn, but they will not enter the land of Israel. Thus you will know that I am the LORD. **Rom. 2:4-8** 4 Or do you think lightly of the riches of His kindness and tolerance and patience, not knowing that the kindness of God leads you to repentance? 5 But because of your stubbornness and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God, 6 who WILL **RENDER TO EACH PERSON ACCORDING TO HIS DEEDS:** 7 to those who by **perseverance in doing good** seek for glory and honor and immortality, **eternal life**; 8 but to those who are selfishly ambitious and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, wrath and indignation.

<u>Rom. 2:9</u> *There will be* tribulation and distress for every soul of man who does evil, of the Jew first and also of the Greek,

<u>Rom. 2:11</u> For there is **no partiality with God**.

<u>Rev. 20:11a</u> ¶ Then I saw a great white throne **and Him who sat upon it,** from whose presence earth and heaven fled away, and no place was found for them.

<u>John 5:22</u> "For not even the Father judges anyone, but **He has given all judgment to** the Son,

John 5:27 and He gave Him authority to execute judgment, because He is *the* Son of Man.

Phil. 2:9-11 9 For this reason also, **God highly exalted Him**, and bestowed on Him **the name which is above every name**, **10** so that at the name of Jesus **EVERY KNEE WILL BOW**, of those who are **in heaven** and **on earth and under the earth**, **11** and that **every tongue will confess** that **Jesus Christ is Lord**, to the **glory of God the Father**.

<u>Rev. 20:11b</u> ¶ Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat upon it, from whose presence earth and heaven fled away, and no place was found for them.

<u>Rev. 20:12, 13</u> 12 And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is *the book* of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds. 13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them; and they were judged, every one *of them* according to their deeds.

<u>Rom. 2:5</u> But because of your stubbornness and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God,

<u>Rom. 6:23a</u> For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

<u>**Rev. 20:14</u>** Then **death and Hades** were thrown into the lake of fire. This is **the second death**, **the lake of fire.**</u>

<u>**Rev. 20:15**</u> And if anyone's **name was not found written in the book of life**, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

<u>Matt. 25:41</u> ¶ "Then He will also say to those on His left, ' Depart from Me, accursed ones, into the eternal fire which has been **prepared for the devil and his angels**;

<u>**2** Pet. 2:4</u> ¶ For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but cast them into hell and committed them to pits of darkness, reserved for judgment;

<u>Jude 6</u> And angels who did not keep their own domain, but abandoned their proper abode, He has kept in eternal bonds under darkness for the judgment of the great day,

<u>**1** Cor. 6:1-3</u> <u>1</u> \P Does any one of you, when he has a case against his neighbor, dare to go to law before the unrighteous and not before the saints?

<u>2</u> Or do you not know that **the saints will judge the world?** If the world is judged by you, are you not competent *to constitute* the smallest law courts?

<u>3</u> Do you not know that we will judge angels? How much more matters of this life?
