## Sermon Scriptures

<u>1 Cor. 5:1</u> ¶ It is actually reported that there is immorality among you, and immorality of such a kind as does not exist even among the Gentiles, that someone has his father's wife.

**Lev. 18:8** 'You shall not uncover the **nakedness of your father's wife**; it is your father's nakedness.

**<u>Deut. 22:30</u>** ¶ "A man shall **not take his father's wife** so that he will not uncover his father's skirt.

<u>1 Cor. 5:2</u> You have become **arrogant and have not mourned instead**, so that the one who had done this deed would **be removed from your midst**.

**<u>1 Cor. 5:3-5</u> 3** ¶ For I, on my part, though **absent in body but present in spirit**, have **already judged him** who has so committed this, as though I were present. **<u>4</u>** In the **name of our Lord Jesus**, when you **are assembled**, and **I with you in spirit**, with the **power** of our Lord Jesus, **<u>5</u>** *I have decided* to **deliver such a one to Satan** for the **destruction of his flesh**, so that his **spirit may be saved** in the **day of the Lord Jesus**.

<u>**1** John 5:16</u> ¶ If anyone sees his brother committing **a sin not** *leading* **to death**, he shall ask and *God* will for him give life to those who commit sin not *leading* to death. There is **a sin** *leading* **to death**; I do not say that he should make request for this.

**<u>1 Cor. 11:30-32</u> 30** For this reason many among you are weak and sick, **and a number sleep. <u>31</u>** But if we judged ourselves rightly, we would not be judged. **<u>32</u>** But when we are judged, we are disciplined by the Lord **so that we will not be condemned along with the world.** 

<u>1 Cor. 3:15</u> If any man's work is burned up, **he will suffer loss**; **but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.** 

<u>**1** Cor. 5:6-8</u> **6** ¶ Your boasting is not good. Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump of dough?

<u>7</u> Clean out the old leaven so that you may be a new lump, just as you are *in fact* **unleavened.** For Christ our Passover also has been sacrificed.

<u>**1** Cor. 5:8</u> Therefore let us celebrate the feast, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

**<u>10</u>** I *did* not at all *mean* with the immoral people of this world, or with the covetous and swindlers, or with idolaters, for then you would have to go out of the world.

<u>11</u> But actually, I wrote to you not to associate with any so-called brother if he is an immoral person, or covetous, or an idolater, or a reviler, or a drunkard, or a swindler — not even to eat with such a one.

**<u>13</u>** But those **who are outside, God judges**. **REMOVE** THE WICKED MAN **FROM AMONG YOURSELVES.**
