I. HE DOSEN'T WANT THEM TO MISS SALVATION --Neither Us

- A. God Is Building A Redemption Inheritance For Himself, Acts 26:17, 18
 - --He wants our children to heed the call to Salvation.
 - 1. Seen in the O. T., Isa. 55:6, 7; Isa. 1:18
 - 2. Seen in the N. T., Jn. 3:16-18
- B. We must encourage them to come to Christ, Mk. 10:13-16
- C. Most Of The Human Race Will Miss God's Great Salvation, Mt. 7:13, 14
- II. GOD DOESN'T WANT OUR CHILDREN TO MISS THE GOOD HE HAS PLANNED FOR THEIR LIVES,
 - --Real living with God's Purposes, and Meaning leading to Eternal Life. --Neither Us
 - A. God Has Planned A More abundant Life For Them, Jn. 10:10; Eph. 3:20, 21
 - B. God wants Our Children To Give Their Lives To To Him, Prov. 3:5-7; Rom. 12:1,2
 - --Even Us

- C. God Has Left On Record Children Who Did Give Themselves To Him. --He will always have some! Rom. 11:3, 4
 - --The Record is for all of us, Rom. 15:4; 1 Cor. 10:11
 - 1. Daniel and his three Friends
 - --The Context –Babylonian Captivity. Dan. 1:1-7
 - a. Obviously saved as children, at this time they are teenagers
 - b. Daniel led their commitment to God, v-1:8
 - c. God moved to honor their commitment to Him, v-9-16; 1 Sam. 2:30
 - d. God blessed them greatly, v-17-20
 - 2. Joseph's Commitment to God is clear in Scripture, Gen. 37:1-50:26
 - --He was seventeen when his life long commitment to God is revealed.
- D. When Our Children Fail, God Wants Them To Come Back To Him,
 - a. God often called Israel back to Himself, Joel 2:12; Zech. 1:3;
 - b. David said this when he returned, Psa. 51:17
 - c. We must help them return, Gal. 6:1
