Sermon Scriptures

<u>Matt. 16:26</u> "For what will it profit a man if **he gains the whole world and forfeits his soul?** Or what will a man **give in exchange for his soul?**

Rom. 5:12 ¶ Therefore, just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men, because all sinned —

<u>Rom. 6:23a</u> For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

<u>Rom. 5:18</u> ¶ So then as through one transgression there resulted **condemnation to all men**, even so through one act of righteousness there resulted justification of life to all men.

<u>1 Tim. 1:15</u> It is a **trustworthy statement**, deserving full acceptance, that **Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners**, among whom I am foremost *of all*.

Matt. 20:28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

<u>John 14:6</u> Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

<u>1 Tim. 2:1</u> ¶ First of all, then, I urge that entreaties *and* prayers, petitions *and* thanksgivings, **be made on behalf of all men**,

Eph. 5:25 ¶ Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her,

Eph. 5:28, 29 28 So **husbands ought also to love their own wives** as their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself; **29** for no one ever hated his own flesh, **but nourishes and cherishes it**, just as Christ also *does* the church,

Gal. 5:22, 23 22 But the **fruit of the Spirit** is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

<u>Job 1:1, 4, 5</u> 1 ¶ There was a man in the land of Uz whose **name was Job**; and that man was **blameless**, **upright**, **fearing God and turning away from evil.** 4 His sons used to go and hold a feast in the house of each one **on his day**, and they would send and invite their three sisters to eat and drink with them.

<u>Job 1:5</u> When the days of feasting had completed their cycle, **Job would send and consecrate them**, rising up early in the morning and offering burnt offerings *according to* the number of them all; for Job said, "Perhaps my sons have sinned and cursed God in their hearts." **Thus Job did continually**.

Josh. 24:14, 15 14 ¶ "Now, therefore, fear the LORD and serve Him in sincerity and truth; and put away the gods which your fathers served beyond the River and in Egypt, and serve the LORD. 15 "If it is disagreeable in your sight to serve the LORD, choose for yourselves today whom you will serve: whether the gods which your fathers served which were beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you are living; but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD."

<u>Deut. 4:10</u> "Remember the day you stood before the LORD your God at Horeb, when the LORD said to me, 'Assemble the people to Me, that I may let them hear My words so they may learn to fear Me all the days they live on the earth, **and that they may teach their children.**'

<u>Deut. 6:7</u> "You shall **teach them diligently to your sons** and shall talk of them when you sit in your house and when you walk by the way and when you lie down and when you rise up.

Eph. 6:4a ¶ **Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger**, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

<u>Col. 3:21</u> Fathers, do not exasperate your children, so that they will not lose heart.

<u>Luke 15:11-24</u> 11 ¶ And He said, "A man had two sons. **12 "The younger** of them said to his father, 'Father, give me the share of the estate that falls to me.' So he divided his wealth between them. 13 "And not many days later, the younger son gathered everything together and went on a journey into a distant country, and there he 14 "Now when he had spent everything, a squandered his estate with loose living. severe famine occurred in that country, and he began to be impoverished. 15 "So he went and hired himself out to one of the citizens of that country, and he sent 16 "And he would have gladly filled his stomach him into his fields to feed swine. with the pods that the swine were eating, and no one was giving anything to him. 17 "But when he came to his senses, he said, 'How many of my father's hired men **have more than enough bread,** but I am dying here with hunger! 18 'I will get up and go to my father, and will say to him, "Father, I have sinned against heaven, and in 19 I am no longer worthy to be called your son; make me as one of your your sight; hired men." 20 "So he got up and came to his father. But while he was still a long way off, his father saw him and felt compassion for him, and ran and embraced him and kissed him. 21 "And the son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and in your sight; I am no longer worthy to be called your son.'

- <u>Luke 15:22</u> "But the father said to his slaves, 'Quickly bring out the best robe and put it on him, and put a ring on his hand and sandals on his feet; 23 and bring the fattened calf, kill it, and let us eat and celebrate; 24 for this son of mine was dead and has come to life again; he was lost and has been found.' And they began to celebrate.
- <u>Luke 15:25-32</u> ¶ "Now his older son was in the field, and when he came and approached the house, he heard music and dancing.
- **<u>26</u>** "And he summoned one of the servants and *began* inquiring what these things could be.
- <u>27</u> "And he said to him, 'Your brother has come, and your father has killed the fattened calf because he has received him back safe and sound.'
- 28 "But he became angry and was not willing to go in; and his father came out and began pleading with him.
- <u>29</u> "But he answered and said to his father, 'Look! For so many years I have been serving you and I have never neglected a command of yours; and *yet* you have never given me a young goat, so that I might celebrate with my friends;
- <u>30</u> but when this son of yours came, who has devoured your wealth with prostitutes, you killed the fattened calf for him.'
- <u>31</u> "And he said to him, 'Son, you have always been with me, and all that is mine is yours.
- <u>32</u> 'But we had to celebrate and rejoice, for this brother of yours was dead and has begun to live, and was lost and has been found."
