III. THE CHURCH WAS TOLERATING SEXUAL SIN IN THEIR PERSONAL LIVES, 1 Cor.6:9-20

A. Those Who **Practice** Sin Will Not Be Part Of God's Saved Family, v-9, 10; Gal. 5:21b

1. Unrighteous People Will Not Inherit God's Eternal Kingdom, v-9a
2. No Other Sin Practicing People Will Inherit God's Eternal Kingdom, v-9b, 10
 - a. None who practice sexual sins in any form (fornicators, adulterers, effeminate, homosexuals)
 - b. None who are idolaters
 - c. None who are thieves, or covetous
 - d. None who are drunkards, or revilers
 - e. None who are swindlers, Etc.;

B. Salvation Has Brought Us A New Life, v-11;

1. God washed us, v-11a; Tit. 3:5
2. God Sanctified us, v-11b; Eph. 5:26
3. God Justified us, v-11c; Rom. 5:1
2 Cor. 5:17; Eph. 5:8

C. Christian Freedom Is Not An Excuse For Being Involved In Sexual sin, 12

D. God Had a Plan For Our Bodies, v-13, 14

1. He planned food for the stomach, v-13a
2. His purposes for both will change one day, v-13b
3. The body is not for immorality, but for the Lord, v-13c
4. God resurrected Christ and will resurrect us also, v-14

E. God Owns The Bodies Of His People, v-15-20

1. We are members of Christ, v-15a
2. Sexual sin violates God's purpose for our body, v-15b-16
3. We are to be one spirit with the Lord, v-17
4. We are to flee from sexual sin, v-18;
--Joseph did, Gen. 39:6-23
5. Our body is the Temple of the Holy Spirit v-19
6. God purchased us with the Death of Christ, and expects us to Glorify Him in our body, v-20
