<u>**1** Cor. 6:9, 10</u> <u>9</u> \P Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived; neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor homosexuals, <u>10</u> nor thieves, nor *the* covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers, will inherit the kingdom of God.

<u>Gal. 5:21b</u> envying, drunkenness, carousing, and things like these, of which I forewarn you, just as I have forewarned you, **that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.**

Gal. 5:19-21a19Now the deeds of the flesh are evident, which are: immorality,
impurity, sensuality,
20 idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, outbursts of
anger, disputes, dissensions, factions,
21 envying, drunkenness, carousing, and things
like these, of which I forewarn you, just as I have forewarned you, that those who
practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

<u>Eph. 5:5, 6</u> 5 For this you know with certainty, that no immoral or impure person or covetous man, who is an idolater, has an inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God. <u>6</u> ¶ Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience.

<u>**1** Cor. 6:11</u> Such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God.

<u>**Titus 3:5**</u> He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the **washing of regeneration** and renewing by the Holy Spirit,

Eph. 5:26 so that He might **sanctify her**, having cleansed her by **the washing of water with the word**,

<u>**Rom. 5:1**</u> ¶ Therefore, having been **justified 1** we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,

<u>2 Cor. 5:17</u> Therefore if anyone is in Christ, *he is* **a new creature;** the old things passed away; behold, **new thing**s have come.

Eph. 5:8 for you were **formerly darkness**, but now you are Light in the Lord; **walk as children of Light**

<u>**1** Cor. 6:12</u> ¶ All things are lawful for me, but not all things are profitable. All things are lawful for me, but I will not be mastered by anything.

<u>1 Cor. 6:13, 14</u> <u>13</u> Food is for the stomach and the stomach is for food, but God will do away with both of them. Yet the body is not for immorality, but for the Lord, and the Lord is for the body. <u>14</u> Now God has not only raised the Lord, but will also raise us up through His power.

<u>1 Cor. 6:15-20</u> 15 Do you not know that **your bodies are members of Christ**? Shall I then take away the members of Christ and make them members of **a prostitute**? **May it never be!**

<u>**16**</u> Or do you not know that the one who joins himself **to a prostitute** is one body *with her?* For He says, "THE TWO SHALL BECOME ONE FLESH."

17 But the one who joins himself to the Lord is one spirit with Him.

<u>18</u> Flee immorality. Every *other* sin that a man commits is outside the body, but the immoral man sins against his own body.

Joseph did! Gen. 39:6-23

<u>Gen. 39:6-23</u> <u>6</u> So he left everything he owned in Joseph's charge; and with him *there* he did not concern himself with anything except the food which he ate. \P Now Joseph was handsome in form and appearance.

<u>7</u> It came about after these events that **his master's wife looked with desire** at Joseph, and she said, **"Lie with me."**

<u>8</u> But **he refused** and said to his master's wife, "Behold, with me *here*, my master does not concern himself with anything in the house, and he has put all that he owns in my charge.

<u>9</u> "There is no one greater in this house than I, and he has withheld nothing from me except you, because you are his wife. How then could I do this great evil and sin against God?"

<u>10</u> As she spoke to Joseph day after day, he did not listen to her to lie beside her *or* be with her.

<u>11</u> Now it happened one day that he went into the house to do his work, and none of the men of the household was there inside.

<u>Gen. 39:12</u> She caught him by his garment, saying, "Lie with me!" And he left his garment in her hand and fled, and went outside.

13 When she saw that he had left his garment in her hand and had fled outside,

<u>14</u> she called to the men of her household and said to them, "See, he has brought in a **Hebrew** to us to make sport of us; he came in to me to lie with me, and I screamed.

 $\underline{15}$ "When he heard that I raised my voice and screamed, he left his garment beside me and fled and went outside."

<u>16</u> So she left his garment beside her until his master came home.

 $\underline{17}$ Then she spoke to him with these words, "The Hebrew slave, whom you brought to us, came in to me to make sport of me;

 $\underline{18}$ and as I raised my voice and screamed, he left his garment beside me and fled outside."

<u>19</u> **Now when his master heard the words of his wife**, which she spoke to him, saying, "This is what your slave did to me," **his anger burned**.

<u>20</u> So Joseph's master took him and put him into the jail, the place where the king's prisoners were confined; and he was there in the jail.

<u>21</u> But the LORD was with Joseph and extended kindness to him, and gave him favor in the sight of the chief jailer.

 $\underline{22}$ The chief jailer committed to Joseph's charge all the prisoners who were in the jail; so that whatever was done there, he was responsible *for it*.

<u>23</u> The chief jailer did not supervise anything under Joseph's charge because the LORD was with him; and whatever he did, the LORD made to prosper.

<u>**1** Cor. 6:19</u> Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own?

<u>1 Cor. 6:20</u> For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body.

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
