--He was greedy for money, so are they.

4. They are like Korah, v-11d;
Num. 16:3, 32-35; Cf. Num. 16:41-50

II. THEY ARE OF NO REAL SPIRITUAL BENEFIT
TO GOD'S PEOPLE, v-12, 13

--Jude uses five natural phenomena to prove his
point.

A. They Are Hidden Reefs At The Church's
Love Feasts, v-12a; 1 Cor. 11:20-22
--A hidden danger to the church!

B. They Are Water Less Clouds Carried On By
Winds, v-12b --A promise , but could not deliver.
Cf. Prov. 25:14

C. They Are Like Autumn Trees Without Fruit,
Doubly Dead, And Uprooted, v-12c; Mt. 21:19;
Mt. 15:13

D. They Are Like Wild Sea Waves, v-13a
--Scripture often uses the wild sea as a picture
of the Lost, Cf. Isa. 57:20, 21

E. They Are Like Shooting Stars, v-13b; Cf. 2 Pet.2:4;
Mt. 8:12

III. ENOCH PROPHESED THE CERTAIN JUDGMENT
OF APOSTATES BY CHRIST AT HIS RETURN,
v-14, 15--They will be in existence even then!

A. Enoch Lived Early In Human History, v-14a;
Gen. 5:21-24; Heb. 11:5

B. The Lord Will Return With His Angels, v-14b
Mt. 25:31; 2 Thess. 1:7-10

C. The Lord Will Come To Execute Judgment On
The Lost, v-15

1. At the end of the Tribulation, Rev. 19:11-15

2. Upon The Anti-Christ, and the False Prophet,
Rev. 19:19, 20

3. Upon the ungodly Armies of the earth,
Rev. 19:21

4. The Lost who survive the Tribulation
Mt. 25:41, 46
