Sermon Scriptures

Jude 14 ¶ *It was also about these men that Enoch, in the seventh generation from Adam,* prophesied, saying, “Behold, the Lord came with **many thousands of His holy ones,**

Gen. 5:21-24 21 ¶ Enoch lived sixty-five years, and became the father of Methuselah. **22** Then **Enoch walked with God three hundred years** after he became the father of Methuselah, and he had *other* sons and daughters. **23** So all the days of Enoch were three hundred and sixty-five years. **24 Enoch walked with God;** and he was not, for **God took him.**

Heb. 11:5 **By faith Enoch was taken up so that he would not see death; AND HE WAS NOT FOUND BECAUSE GOD TOOK HIM UP;** for he obtained the witness that before his being taken up he was pleasing to God.

2 Kings 2:11, 12, 15-18 11 As they were going along and talking, behold, *there appeared* a chariot of fire and horses of fire which separated the two of them. And Elijah **went up by a whirlwind to heaven.** **12** Elisha saw *it* and cried out, “My father, my father, the chariots of Israel and its horsemen!” And **he saw Elijah no more.** Then he took hold of his own clothes and tore them in two pieces. **15** ¶ Now when **the sons of the prophets** who *were* at Jericho opposite *him* saw him, they said, “The spirit of Elijah rests on Elisha.” And they came to meet him and bowed themselves to the ground before him. **16** They said to him, “Behold now, there are with your servants fifty strong men, please **let them go and search for your master;** perhaps the Spirit of the LORD has taken him up and cast him on some mountain or into some valley.” And he said, **“You shall not send.”** **17** But when they urged him until he was ashamed, he said, “Send.” They sent therefore fifty men; **and they searched three days but did not find him.** **18** They returned to him while he was staying at Jericho; and he said to them, **“Did I not say to you, ‘Do not go’?”**

1 Cor. 15:51, 52 51 Behold, I tell you a mystery; **we will not all sleep, but we will all be changed,** **52** in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet; for the trumpet will sound, and **the dead will be raised** imperishable, and **we will be changed.**

1 Thess. 4:14-17 14 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him **those who have fallen asleep in Jesus.** **15** For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that **we who are alive and remain** until the coming of the Lord, **will not precede those who have fallen asleep.** **16** For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of *the* archangel and with the trumpet of God,

and the dead in Christ will rise first.

1 Thess. 4:17 Then **we who are alive and remain** will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we shall always be with the Lord.

Matt. 25:31 ¶ “But when the Son of Man comes in His glory, and **all the angels with Him,** then He will sit on His glorious throne.

2 Thess. 1:7-10 **7** and *to give* relief to you who are afflicted and to us as well when the Lord Jesus will be revealed from heaven **with His mighty angels in flaming fire,** **8** dealing out **retribution** to those **who do not know God** and to those who **do not obey the gospel** of our Lord Jesus. **9** These will pay the **penalty of eternal destruction,** away **from the presence** of the Lord and **from the glory of His power,** **10** when He comes to be glorified in His saints on that day, and to be marveled at among all who have believed — for our testimony to you was believed.

Jude 15 to execute **judgment upon all,** and to convict all **the ungodly** of all their ungodly deeds which they have done in an ungodly way, and of **all the harsh things** which **ungodly sinners** have **spoken against Him.”**

Rev. 19:11-15 **11** ¶ And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat on it *is* called Faithful and True, and **in righteousness He judges and wages war.** **12** His eyes *are* a flame of fire, and on His head *are* many diadems; and He has a name written *on Him* which no one knows except Himself. **13** *He is* clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and **His name is called The Word of God.** **14** And the **armies which are in heaven,** clothed in fine linen, white *and* clean, **were following Him on white horses.** **15** From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and **He treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty.**

John 1:1 ¶ In the beginning was **the Word,** and the **Word was with God,** and the **Word was God.**

Rev. 19:19, 20 **19** ¶ And I saw the beast and the **kings of the earth and their armies assembled to make war against Him** who sat on the horse **and against His army.** **20** And **the beast** was seized, and with him **the false prophet** who performed the signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image; **these two were thrown alive into the lake of fire which burns with brimstone.**

2 Kings 6:15-17 **15** ¶ Now when the attendant of the man of God had risen early and gone out, **behold, an army with horses and chariots was circling the city.** And his

servant said to him, “Alas, my master! What shall we do?”

2 Kings 6:16 So he answered, “Do not fear, **for those who are with us are more than those who are with them.**” **17** Then **Elisha prayed** and said, “O LORD, I pray, **open his eyes that he may see.**” And the LORD opened the servant’s eyes and he saw; and behold, **the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha.**

Rev. 19:21 And **the rest were killed with the sword which came from the mouth of Him** who sat on the horse, and **all the birds were filled with their flesh.**

Rev. 19:17, 18 **17** ¶ Then I saw an angel standing in the sun, and he cried out with a loud voice, **saying to all the birds which fly in midheaven, “Come, assemble for the great supper of God,**

18 so that **you may eat the flesh of kings** and the flesh of **commanders** and the flesh of **mighty men** and the flesh of **horses** and of **those who sit on them** and the flesh of **all men**, both **free men and slaves, and small and great.**”

Matt. 25:41 ¶ “Then He will also say to those on His left, ‘Depart from Me, accursed ones, **into the eternal fire** which has been prepared for the devil and his angels;

Matt. 25:46 “**These will go away into eternal punishment**, but the righteous into eternal life.”
