Sunday, July 19, 2020 Sermon Scriptures

<u>Jude 16</u> These are **grumblers**, **finding fault**, following after their *own* lusts; they speak arrogantly, flattering people for the sake of *gaining an* advantage.

<u>Jude 15b</u> to execute judgment upon all, and to convict all the ungodly of all their ungodly deeds which they have done in an ungodly way, and **of all the harsh things** which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him."

Ex. 16:7-9 7 and in the morning you will see the glory of the LORD, for **He hears your grumblings against the LORD**; and what are we, that you grumble against us?" **8** Moses said, "*This will happen* when the LORD gives you meat to eat in the evening, and bread to the full in the morning; for **the LORD hears your grumblings which you grumble against Him.** And what are we? Your grumblings are not against us but against the LORD." **9** Then Moses said to Aaron, "Say to all the congregation of the sons of Israel, ' Come near before the LORD, **for He has heard your grumblings.**""

<u>Num. 14:27</u> "How long *shall I bear* with this evil congregation who are grumbling against Me? I have heard the complaints of the sons of Israel, which they are making against Me.

<u>Num. 14:29</u> your corpses will fall in this wilderness, even all your numbered men, according to your complete number from twenty years old and upward, **who have grumbled against Me.**

<u>**1** Cor. 10:5, 6, 10-12</u> <u>5</u> Nevertheless, with most of them God was not well-pleased; for they were laid low in the wilderness. <u>6</u> \P Now these things happened **as examples for us,** so that we would not crave evil things as they also craved. <u>10</u> Nor grumble, as some of them did, and were destroyed by the destroyer. <u>11</u> Now **these things** happened to them **as an example**, and they were **written for our instruction**, upon whom the ends of the ages have come. <u>12</u> Therefore let him who thinks he stands take heed that he does not fall.

<u>Job 32:1-3</u> ¶ Then these three men ceased answering Job, because he was righteous in his own eyes. <u>2</u> But **the anger of Elihu** the son of Barachel the Buzite, of the family of Ram **burned; against Job his anger burned because he justified himself before God.** <u>3</u> And his anger **burned against his three friends** because they had found no answer, **and yet had condemned Job.**

Job 33:8-13 8 ¶ "Surely you have spoken in my hearing, And I have heard the

sound of your words:

<u>Job 33:9</u> 'I am pure, without transgression; I am innocent and there is no guilt in me. <u>10</u> 'Behold, He invents pretexts against me; He counts me as His enemy. <u>11</u> 'He puts my feet in the stocks; He watches all my paths.' <u>12</u> "Behold, let me tell you, you are not right in this, For God is greater than man. <u>13</u> ¶ "Why do you complain against Him That He does not give an account of all His doings?

<u>Job 38:1-3</u> 1 ¶ Then the LORD answered Job out of the whirlwind and said, <u>2</u> "Who is this that darkens counsel **By words without knowledge**? <u>3</u> "Now gird up your loins like a man, **And I will ask you, and you instruct Me!**

<u>Jude 16c</u> These are grumblers, finding fault, following after their *own* lusts; they speak arrogantly, flattering people for the sake of *gaining an* advantage.

<u>Rom. 16:18a</u> For such men are **slaves, not of our Lord Christ but of their own appetites**; and by their smooth **and flattering speech they deceive** the hearts of the unsuspecting.

Prov. 28:25 An **arrogant man** stirs up strife, But he who trusts in the LORD will prosper.

<u>Jude 17, 18</u> <u>17</u> ¶ But you, beloved, **ought to remember** the words that were spoken beforehand **by the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ**,

<u>Jude 18</u> that they were saying to you, "In the last time there will be mockers, following after their own ungodly lusts."

<u>Matt. 7:15</u> ¶ "Beware of the false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly are ravenous wolves.

Matt. 24:11 "Many false prophets will arise and will mislead many.

<u>**2 Pet. 3:3</u>** Know this first of all, that in the last days mockers will come with *their* mocking, following after their own lusts,</u>

Jude 19 These are the ones who cause divisions, worldly-minded, devoid of the Spirit.

<u>Acts 20:29, 30</u> <u>29</u> "I know that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; <u>30</u> and from among your own selves men will arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after them.

<u>Eph. 4:1-4</u> ¶ Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called, $\underline{2}$ with all humility and

gentleness, with patience, showing tolerance for one another in love, <u>Eph. 4:3</u> being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. <u>4</u> *There is* one body and one Spirit, just as also you were called in one hope of your calling;

Jude 19b These are the ones who cause divisions, worldly-minded, devoid of the Spirit.

James 3:14, 15 14 But if you have bitter jealousy and selfish ambition in your heart, do not be arrogant and *so* lie against the truth.

<u>15</u> This wisdom is not that which comes down from above, **but is earthly, natural, demonic.**

<u>Rom. 8:9</u> ¶ However, you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. **But if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him.**

<u>**1** John 4:13</u> By this we know that we abide in Him and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit.

<u>Titus 1:16</u> They profess to know God, but by *their* deeds they deny *Him*, being detestable and disobedient and worthless for any good deed.
