Sermon Scriptures

<u>Jude 21a</u> keep yourselves in the love of God, waiting anxiously for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to eternal life.

<u>John 15:9, 10 9</u> "Just as the Father has loved Me, I have also loved you; **abide in My love**. <u>10</u> "If you **keep My commandments, you will abide in My love**; just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.

<u>Jude 20a</u> But you, beloved, **building yourselves up** on your **most holy faith**, praying in the Holy Spirit,

<u>Jude 3</u> ¶ Beloved, while I was making every effort to write you about our common salvation, I felt the necessity to write to you appealing that you contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all handed down to the saints.

<u>John 17:17</u> "Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth.

<u>1 Pet. 2:2</u> like newborn babies, long for the **pure milk of the word**, so that **by it you may grow** in respect to salvation,

Acts 20:32 "And now I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all those who are sanctified.

<u>Jude 20b</u> But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, **praying in** the Holy Spirit,

<u>1 Cor. 12:28-30</u> <u>28</u> And God has appointed in the church, **first** apostles, **second** prophets, **third** teachers, **then** miracles, **then** gifts of healings, helps, administrations, *various* **kinds of tongues**. <u>29</u> All are not apostles, are they? All are not prophets, are they? All are not teachers, are they? All are not *workers of* miracles, are they? <u>30</u> All do not have gifts of healings, do they? All do not speak with tongues, do they? All do not interpret, do they?

Eph. 5:18 And do not get drunk with wine, for that is dissipation, **but be filled** with the Spirit,

<u>James 5:16</u> Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.

<u>Titus 2:13, 14</u> <u>13</u> <u>looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Christ Jesus, <u>14</u> who gave Himself for us to redeem us **from every lawless deed, and to purify** for Himself a people for His own possession, **zealous for good deeds.**</u>

<u>Jude 22</u> And have mercy on some, who are doubting;

<u>Gal. 3:1</u> ¶ You foolish Galatians, who has bewitched you, before whose eyes Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed as crucified?

<u>Jude 23</u> save others, snatching them out of the fire; and on some have mercy with fear, hating even the garment polluted by the flesh.

<u>1 Pet. 5:8</u> Be of sober *spirit*, be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.

<u>Jude 4</u> For certain persons have crept in unnoticed, those who were long beforehand marked out for this condemnation, **ungodly persons who turn the grace of our God into licentiousness** and deny our only Master and Lord, Jesus Christ.
