<u>Jude 1</u> ¶ Jude, a bond-servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, ¶ To those who are **the called, beloved in God the Father**, and **kept** for Jesus Christ:

<u>John 6:37-40</u> 37 "All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will certainly not cast out. <u>38</u> "For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me. <u>39</u> "This is the will of Him who sent Me, that of all that He has given Me I lose nothing, but raise it up on the last day. <u>40</u> "For this is the will of My Father, that everyone who beholds the Son and believes in Him will have eternal life, and I Myself will raise him up on the last day."

<u>Jude 24</u> ¶ Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to make you stand in the presence of His glory blameless with great joy,

<u>1 Cor. 10:13</u> No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and **God** is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, so that you will be able to endure it.

<u>**1** John 1:9</u> If we confess our sins, **He is faithful and righteous to forgive us** our sins and to **cleanse us** from all unrighteousness.

<u>John 17:5</u> "Now, Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was.

<u>Matt. 17:1-3</u> 1 ¶ Six days later Jesus took with Him Peter and James and John his brother, and led them up on a high mountain by themselves. 2 And He was transfigured before them; and His face shone like the sun, and His garments became as white as light. 3 And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, talking with Him.

Acts 7:2 ¶ And he said, "Hear me, brethren and fathers! **The God of glory** appeared to our father Abraham when he was in Mesopotamia, before he lived in Haran,

Ex. 33:18, 20-23 18 Then Moses said, "I pray You, **show me Your glory**!" <u>20</u> But He said, "**You cannot see My face**, for no man can see Me and live!" <u>21</u> Then the LORD said, "Behold, there is a place by Me, and you shall stand *there* on the rock; <u>22</u> and it will come about, **while My glory is passing by**, that I will put you in the cleft of the rock and **cover you with My hand** until I have passed by. <u>23</u> "Then I will take My hand away and **you shall see My back, but My face shall not be seen.**" **<u>Rom. 8:1</u>** ¶ Therefore there is now **no condemnation** for those who are **in Christ Jesus**.

<u>Jude 24</u> ¶ Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to make you stand in the presence of His glory blameless with great joy,

Eph. 5:27 that He might **present to Himself the church in all her glory**, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she would be holy and **blameless**.

<u>Psa. 16:11</u> You will make known to me the path of life; **In Your presence is fullness of joy;** In Your right hand there are **pleasures forever**.

<u>**Psa. 68:3</u>** But let **the righteous be glad**; let them exult before God; Yes, let them **rejoice** with gladness.</u>

<u>Jude 25</u> to the only God our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, *be* glory, majesty, dominion and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen.

<u>Isa. 44:6</u> " "Thus says **the LORD**, the King of Israel and his Redeemer, **the LORD of hosts:** 'I am the first and I am the last, And **there is no God besides Me**.

Isa. 45:21, 22 21 "Declare and set forth *your case;* Indeed, let them consult together. Who has announced this from of old? Who has long since declared it? Is it not I, the LORD? And there is no other God besides Me, A righteous God and a Savior; There is none except Me. <u>22</u> "Turn to Me and be saved, all the ends of the earth; For I am God, and there is no other.

<u>1 Tim. 2:5</u> For there is one God, *and* one mediator also between God and men, *the* man Christ Jesus,

<u>Acts 2:36</u> ¶ "Therefore let all the house of Israel know for certain that God has made Him both Lord and Christ — this Jesus whom you crucified."

<u>Rom. 1:7</u> ¶ to all who are beloved of God in Rome, called *as* saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and **the Lord Jesus Christ**.

Luke 6:46 ¶ "Why do you call Me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say?

<u>Col. 1:13-20</u> <u>13</u> For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son, <u>14</u> in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins. <u>15</u> ¶ He is **the image of the invisible God**, the firstborn of all creation. <u>16</u> For **by Him all things were created**, *both* in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities — **all things have been created through Him and for Him**. <u>17</u> He is **before all things**, and **in Him** all things hold

together. <u>18</u> He is also head of the body, the church; and He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, so that He Himself will come to have first place in everything. <u>Col. 1:19</u> For it was the *Father's* good pleasure for all the fullness to dwell in Him, <u>20</u> and through Him to reconcile all things to Himself, having made peace through the blood of His cross; through Him, *I say*, whether things on earth or things in heaven.

<u>Jude 25</u> to the only God our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, *be* glory, majesty, dominion and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen.

<u>**Heb. 1:1-3**</u> \P God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways,

<u>2</u> in these last days has spoken to us in His Son, whom **He appointed heir of all things**, through whom also He made the world.

<u>3</u> And **He is the radiance of His glory** and the **exact representation of His nature**, and upholds all things by the word of His power. When He had made purification of sins, **He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high**,
