Sermon Scriptures

<u>2 Pet. 3:10-13</u> <u>10</u> But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, in which the heavens will pass away with a roar and the elements will be destroyed with intense heat, and the earth and its works will be burned up. <u>11</u> ¶ Since all these things are to be destroyed in this way, what sort of people ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness, <u>12</u> looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be destroyed by burning, and the elements will melt with intense heat! <u>13</u> But according to His promise we are looking for new heavens and a new earth, in which righteousness dwells.

<u>Isa. 65:17</u> ¶ "For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth; And the former things will not be remembered or come to mind.

<u>Isa. 66:22</u> "For just as **the new heavens and the new earth** Which I make will endure before Me," declares the LORD, "So your offspring and your name will endure.

<u>Rev. 21:2, 22, 23</u> And I saw the holy city, **new Jerusalem**, coming down out of heaven from God, made ready as a bride adorned for her husband. $22 \ \P$ I saw no temple in it, for the Lord God the Almighty and the Lamb are its temple. And the city has **no need of the sun or of the moon to shine on it,** for the glory of God has illumined it, and its lamp *is* the Lamb.

Rev. 21:1, 5 1 ¶ Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth; for the first heaven and the first earth passed away, and there is no longer any sea. 5 ¶ And He who sits on the throne said, "Behold, I am making all things new." And He said, "Write, for these words are faithful and true."

<u>Gen. 4:26</u> To Seth, to him also a son was born; and he called **his name Enosh**. Then *men* began to **call upon the name of the LORD**.

Gen. 5:22, 24 22 Then Enoch walked with God three hundred years after he became the father of Methuselah, and he had *other* sons and daughters. 24 Enoch walked with God; and he was not, for God took him.

Rom. 9:30 ¶ What shall we say then? **That Gentiles,** who did not pursue righteousness, attained righteousness, even the righteousness which is by faith;

Rom. 11:11 ¶ I say then, they did not stumble so as to fall, did they? May it never be! But by their transgression salvation *has come* to the Gentiles, to make them jealous.

<u>Rev. 7:4</u> ¶ And I heard the number of those who were sealed, **one hundred and forty- four thousand sealed from every tribe of the sons of Israel:**

Rev. 7:9, 10 9 ¶ After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could count, from every nation and all tribes and peoples and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, and palm branches were in their hands; $\underline{10}$ and they cry out with a loud voice, saying, ¶ "Salvation to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb."

Matt. 25:33, 34 33 and He will put the sheep on His right, and the goats on the left. 34 ¶ "Then the King will say to those on His right, 'Come, you who are blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world.

<u>Isa. 65:17</u> ¶ "For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth; And the former things will not be remembered or come to mind.

Rev. 21:3, 4 3 And I heard a loud voice from the throne, saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is among men, and **He will dwell among them**, and they shall be His people, and God Himself will be among them, 4 and He will wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there will **no longer be** *any* death; there will **no longer be** *any* mourning, or crying, or pain; **the first things have passed away**."

Rev. 21:8, 27 8 "But for the cowardly and unbelieving and abominable and murderers and immoral persons and sorcerers and idolaters and all liars, their part will be in the lake that burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death."

27 and nothing unclean, and no one who practices abomination and lying, shall ever come into it, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life.

<u>Rev. 22:3</u> There will no longer be any curse; and the throne of God and of the Lamb will be in it, and **His bond-servants will serve Him**;

Rev. 22:4 they will **see His face**, and **His name** *will be* **on their foreheads**.

<u>Rev. 22:5</u> And there will no longer be *any* night; and **they will not have need of the light of a lamp** nor the light of the sun, because **the Lord God will illumine them**; and **they will reign forever and ever**.

<u>Rev. 22:6</u> ¶ And he said to me, "These words are faithful and true"; and the Lord, the God of the spirits of the prophets, sent His angel to show to His bond-servants the things which must soon take place.
