I. SAUL WAS THE GREAT ENEMY OF THE EARLY CHURCH

- A. He Persecuted The Church At Jerusalem Greatly, Acts 22:4; 26:9-11; Acts 7:54-58
- B. He Sought To Take His Persecution To Damascus, Acts 9:1, 2

II. THE LORD SAVES SAUL OF TARSUS

- A. The Lord Encounters Him On The Road To Damascus
 - 1. The Glory of Christ flashed all around him, Acts 9:3; 26:13
 - 2. The Lord confronted him about persecuting Him, Acts 9:4; 26:14
 - 3. Saul answers Him and the Lord identifies Himself, Acts 9:5; 22:8,9
 - 4. Saul surrenders himself to the Lord, Acts 22:10a
 - 5. The Lord tells Saul what to do, Acts 9:6
 - 6. The Lord explains His task He has assigned him, Acts 26:16-18; Rom. 11:13
 - a. To be a Minister and Witness, v-16
 - b. To bring the Gentiles to Him, v-17,18
 - c. The Apostle to Gentiles, Rom. 11:13
