<u>Luke 7:6-8</u> 6 Now Jesus *started* on His way with them; and **when He was not far from the house**, the centurion **sent friends**, saying to Him, "Lord, do not trouble Yourself further, for **I am not worthy** for You **to come under my roof**; **7** for this reason **I did not even consider myself worthy to come** to You, but *just* **say the word**, **and my servant will be healed**. **8** "For I also am **a man placed under authority**, with **soldiers under me**; and I say to this one, 'Go!' and he goes, and to another, 'Come!' and he comes, and to my slave, 'Do this!' and he does it."

<u>Matt. 8:10</u> Now when Jesus heard *this*, He marveled and said to those who were following, "Truly I say to you, I have not found such great faith with anyone in Israel.

<u>Matt. 8:11</u> "I say to you that many will come from east and west, and recline at the table with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven;

<u>Matt. 8:12</u> but the sons of the kingdom will be cast out into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."
