IV. PAUL BOASTS OF VISIONS AND REVELATIONS,
2 Cor. 12:1-6; Acts 26:16; Col. 2:18

A. He Was Caught Up To Heaven, 2 Cor. 12:2-5;
2 Cor. 4:17

B. Paul Explains Why He Doesn't Want To Boast,
v-6

C. To Keep Paul From Being Overcome Of The
Many Revelations, God Gave Him A Thorn In
The Flesh, v-7-10

1. It was given to keep Paul from exalting
himself, v-7

2. He prayed three times to the Lord that it
might leave him, v-8

3. The Lord told him that His Grace was
sufficient for him, v-9a

4. Paul surrendered to the Lord's will and
power in his life, v-9b-10

D. Paul Ends His Boasting In The Lord, v-11, 12

1. He states that he was compelled to boast,
v-11a

2. He affirms again that he was not inferior
to any of the Apostles, v-11b

3. He possessed all the signs of a true Apostle,
v-12; 2 Thess. 2:1-3, 8, 9

E. Paul Makes It Clear That He Has Been Boasting
All Of This For Their Spiritual Growing, v-19
