<u>2 Cor. 12:1</u> ¶ **Boasting is necessary**, though it is not profitable; **but I will go on to visions and revelations of the Lord.**

<u>Col. 2:18</u> Let no one **keep defrauding you of your prize** by delighting in self-abasement and the worship of the angels, **taking his stand on** *visions* **he has seen**, inflated without cause by his fleshly mind,

Acts 26:16 'But get up and stand on your feet; for this purpose I have appeared to you, to appoint you a minister and a witness not only to the things which you have seen, but also to the things in which I will appear to you;

<u>2 Cor. 12:2-5</u> <u>2</u> I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago — whether in the body I do not know, or out of the body I do not know, God knows — such a man was caught up to the third heaven. <u>3</u> And I know how such a man — whether in the body or apart from the body I do not know, God knows — <u>4</u> was caught up into Paradise and heard inexpressible words, which a man is not permitted to speak. <u>5</u> On behalf of such a man I will boast; but on my own behalf I will not boast, except in regard to my weaknesses.

<u>2 Cor. 4:17</u> For momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison,

<u>2 Cor. 12:6</u> For if I do wish to boast I will not be foolish, for I will be speaking the truth; but I refrain *from this*, so that no one will credit me with more than he sees *in* me or hears from me.

<u>2 Cor. 12:7-10</u> 7 Because of the surpassing greatness of the revelations, for this reason, to keep me from exalting myself, there was given me a thorn in the flesh, a messenger of Satan to torment me — to keep me from exalting myself!

<u>8</u> Concerning this I implored the Lord three times that it might leave me. <u>9</u> And He has said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for power is perfected in weakness." Most gladly, therefore, I will rather boast about my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may dwell in me. <u>10</u> Therefore I am well content with weaknesses, with insults, with distresses, with persecutions, with difficulties, for Christ's sake; for when I am weak, then I am strong.

2 Cor. 12:11, 12 11 ¶ I have become foolish; you yourselves compelled me. Actually I should have been commended by you, for in no respect was I inferior to the

most eminent apostles, even though I am a nobody.

- <u>1 Cor. 15:10</u> But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me did not prove vain; but I labored even more than all of them, yet not I, but the grace of God with me.
- 2 Cor. 12:<u>12</u> The signs of a true apostle were performed among you with all perseverance, by signs and wonders and miracles.
- <u>2 Thess 2:1-3</u> ¶ Now we request you, brethren, with regard to the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our gathering together to Him, <u>2</u> that you not be quickly shaken from your composure or be disturbed either by a spirit or a message or a letter as if from us, to the effect **that the day of the Lord has come**. <u>3 Let no one in any way deceive</u> **you,** for *it will not come* unless the apostasy comes first, and **the man of lawlessness is revealed,** the son of destruction,
- <u>2 Thess. 2:8, 9</u> <u>8</u> Then that lawless one will be revealed whom the Lord will slay with the breath of His mouth and bring to an end by the appearance of His coming; <u>9</u> that is, the one whose coming is in accord with the activity of Satan, with all power and signs and false wonders,

<u>2 Cor. 12:19</u> ¶ All this time you have been thinking that we are defending ourselves to you. Actually, it is in the sight of God that we have been speaking in Christ; and all for your upbuilding, beloved.
