III. THE LORD FELT COMPASSION FOR THE WIDOW
v-13a

- A. The Lord Often Was Moved With Compassion For People, v-Matt. 9:36; 14:14
- B. The Lord Reaches Out To The Widow, v-13b
- C. God Has Always Had Concern For Widows,
 - 1. Psa. 68:5 states it clearly
 - 2. Jer. 49:11 –God emphasizes it in His statement of judgment against Israel.
 - 3. Lk. 20:46, 47 –The Lord condemned the Religious Leaders for their mistreatment of the widows.
- D. But The Widows In Israel Have Not Always Been As Faithful To God As He Wanted Them To Be
 - 1. The Lord reminded His hometown of this, Lk. 4:24-26, 28,29
 - 2. The Incident Is Recorded In 1 Ki. 17:9-16

IV. THE LORD RESTORES THE WIDOW'S SON TO HER, v-14, 15

- A. He Touched The Coffin And Told The Dead Man To Arise, v-14
- B. The Dead Man Arose, v-15
 - 1. He sat up, v-15a
 - 2. He began to speak, v-15b
 - 3. The Lord gave him back to his Mother, v-15c

V. THE CROWDS RESPONDED, v-16, 17

- A. Fear Gripped Them All, v-16a
- B. They Gave Glory To God, v-16b
- C. They Told The Report Of This Miracle Credential, v-17
