III. THE WEAK AND STRONG IN FAITH ARE NOT TO JUDGE EACH OTHER, v-3, 4

- A. The One Strong In Faith Is Not To Treat The One Weak In Faith With Contempt, v-3a
- B. The One Weak In Faith Is Not To Judge The One Who Does Eat, v-3b
- C. God Has Accepted Each Of Them So They Are Not To Judge Each Other, v-3c
- D. How Dare We Judge God's Servant? v-4
 - 1. God's Servant stands or falls before Him, v-4a
 - 2. God is able to make His Servant stand before Him, v-4b

IV. WEAK AND STRONG BELIEVERS CAN BE ILLUSTRATED IN THE OBSERVANCE OF DAYS, v-5

- A. The Weak believer Felt Compelled To Observe Special Days, v-5a
- B. The Strong Believer Regarded Every Day Alike, v-5b
- C. Paul Said Each Person Was To Be Compelled Within His Own Conscience, v-5c
 - Conscience is very important! Acts 24:16
 - 1. God gave man a conscience, Cf. Rom. 2:14, 15
 - 2. Conscience can be rendered ineffective. 1 Tim. 4:1, 2; Tit. 1:15

V. THE WEAK AND STRONG BELIEVER BOTH MUST ALWAYS HAVE THEIR FOCUS ON THE LORD, v-6-9

- A. The Observing Of Days Or Eating Must Be For The Lord, v-6
- B. Our Living And Death Must Both Be For The Lord, v-7, 8
- C. Christ's Death And Resurrection Were That He Would Be Lord Of the Redeemed In Heaven And On Earth, v-9; Cf. Phil. 2:9-11

VI. PAUL SHOWS THE FOLLY OF BELIEVERS JUDGING EACH OTHER, v-10-13

- A. He Questions Why We Judge Each Other, v-10a

- B. He Questions Why We Treat Each Other With Contempt, v-10b
- C. He Says We All Will Stand Before The Judgment Seat Of God, v-10c; Cf. 1 Cor. 3:10-15
- D. The Prophets Foretold It, v-11
- E. Each Of Us Believers Will Give An Account Of Our Self To God, v-12
- F. Therefore We Need To Look Out For Each Other,
 - 1. By stop judging each other, v-13a
 - 2. By being determined to not put a stumbling block in anyone's way, v-13b; Mt. 18:6, 7

VII. THINGS THAT ARE NOT UNCLEAN IN THEMSELVES CAN BE MADE UNCLEAN IN A BELIEVER'S LIFE, v-14-16

- A. In The Lord Jesus Nothing Is Unclean In Itself, v-14a; Acts 10:9-22
- B. The Person Who Thinks Something Is Unclean, It Is Unclean To Them, v-14b
- C. Hurting Your Christian Brother With The Exercise Of Your Christian Liberty Means, v-15
 - 1. You are not walking together in love, v-15a Jn. 13:34, 35
 - 2. You need to stop destroying your brother for whom Christ died, v-15b
- D. Therefore Do Not Let The Exercise Of Your Christian Liberty Be Spoken Of As Evil, v-16
