**1 Thess. 1:6** You also became imitators of us and of the Lord, having received the word in much tribulation **with the joy of the Holy Spirit,**

**Rom. 14:18** For he who in this *way* serves Christ is **acceptable to God** and **approved** by men.

**Phil. 2:14, 15** **14** ¶ Do all things **without grumbling or disputing;** **15** so that you will **prove yourselves to be blameless and innocent,** children of God **above reproach** in the midst of a **crooked and perverse generation,** among whom you appear as lights in the world,

**Rom. 14:19** So then we pursue the things which **make for peace** and the **building up of one another.**

**1 Thess. 5:11** Therefore encourage one another and **build up one another,** just as you also are doing.

**Eph. 4:1-3** **1** ¶ Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, **implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling** with which you have been called, **2** with **all humility and gentleness,** with patience, **showing tolerance** for one another **in love,** **3** **being diligent to preserve the unity** of the Spirit in the **bond of peace.**

**1 Pet. 3:10-13** **10** For, **“THE ONE WHO DESIRES LIFE, TO LOVE AND SEE GOOD DAYS, MUST KEEP HIS TONGUE FROM EVIL AND HIS LIPS FROM SPEAKING DECEIT. 11 “HE MUST TURN AWAY FROM EVIL AND DO GOOD; HE MUST SEEK PEACE AND PURSUE IT. 12 “FOR THE EYES OF THE LORD ARE TOWARD THE RIGHTEOUS, AND HIS EARS ATTEND TO THEIR PRAYER, BUT THE FACE OF THE LORD IS AGAINST THOSE WHO DO EVIL.”**

**Heb. 10:23, 24 23** Let us **hold fast** the confession of our hope **without wavering**, for He who promised is faithful; **24** and let us **consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds**,

**Rom. 14:20** Do **not tear down the work of God** for the sake of food. All things indeed are clean, **but** they are evil for the man **who eats and gives offense**.

**Eph. 2:10** For we are **His workmanship**, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.

**Rom. 14:21-23 21** It is good not to eat meat or to drink wine, **or to do anything by which your brother stumbles**.

**Rom. 14:22** **The faith** which you have, have **as your own conviction before God**. Happy is he who does not condemn himself in what he approves.

**Rom. 14:23** **But he who doubts** is condemned if he eats, because *his eating is* not from faith; and **whatever is not from faith is sin**.
