<u>Rom. 14:17</u> for the **kingdom of God** is not eating and drinking, **but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.**

<u>**1** Thess. 1:6</u> You also became imitators of us and of the Lord, having received the word in much tribulation with the joy of the Holy Spirit,

<u>Rom. 14:18</u> For he who in this *way* serves Christ is acceptable to God and approved by men.

<u>Phil. 2:14, 15</u> <u>14</u> \P Do all things without grumbling or disputing; <u>15</u> so that you will prove yourselves to be blameless and innocent, children of God above reproach in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you appear as lights in the world,

<u>Rom. 14:19</u> So then we pursue the things which **make for peace** and the **building up of one another.**

<u>**1** Thess. 5:11</u> Therefore encourage one another and **build up one another**, just as you also are doing.

Eph. 4:1-3 1 ¶ Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, **implore you to walk** in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called, 2 with all humility and gentleness, with patience, showing tolerance for one another in love, 3 being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

<u>1 Pet. 3:10-13</u> 10 For, "THE ONE **WHO DESIRES LIFE, TO LOVE** AND SEE **GOOD DAYS**, MUST **KEEP HIS TONGUE FROM EVIL** AND HIS LIPS **FROM SPEAKING DECEIT. <u>11</u>** "HE MUST **TURN AWAY FROM EVIL** AND DO GOOD; HE MUST **SEEK PEACE AND PURSUE IT. <u>12</u>** "FOR THE **EYES OF THE LORD** ARE **TOWARD THE RIGHTEOUS**, AND **HIS EARS ATTEND** TO THEIR PRAYER, **BUT THE FACE** OF THE LORD IS **AGAINST** THOSE WHO DO EVIL." <u>Heb. 10:23, 24</u> <u>23</u> Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful; <u>24</u> and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds,

<u>Rom. 14:20</u> Do **not tear down the work of God** for the sake of food. All things indeed are clean, **but** they are evil for the man **who eats and gives**

offense.

Eph. 2:10 For we are **His workmanship**, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.

<u>Rom. 14:21-23</u> It is good not to eat meat or to drink wine, or *to do anything* by which your brother stumbles.

<u>Rom. 14:22</u> The faith which you have, have as your own conviction before God. Happy is he who does not condemn himself in what he approves.

<u>Rom. 14:23</u> But he who doubts is condemned if he eats, because *his eating is* not from faith; and whatever is not from faith is sin.
