<u>Matt. 11:2</u> ¶ Now when John, while imprisoned, heard of the works of Christ, he sent word by his disciples

<u>Luke 7:18</u> ¶ The disciples of John **reported to him** about all these things.

Matt. 11:3 and said to Him, "Are You the Expected One, or shall we look for someone else?"

John 1:19-24 19 ¶ This is the testimony of John, when the Jews sent to him priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, "Who are you?" 20 And he confessed and did not deny, but confessed, "I am not the Christ." 21 They asked him, "What then? Are you Elijah?" And he said, "I am not." "Are you the Prophet?" And he answered, "No." 22 Then they said to him, "Who are you, so that we may give an answer to those who sent us? What do you say about yourself?" 23 He said, "I am A VOICE OF ONE CRYING IN THE WILDERNESS, 'MAKE STRAIGHT THE WAY OF THE LORD,' as Isaiah the prophet said." 24 ¶ Now they had been sent from the Pharisees.

<u>John 1:29-36</u> <u>29</u> ¶ The next day he saw Jesus coming to him and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! <u>30</u> "This is He on behalf of whom I said, 'After me comes a Man who has a higher rank than I, for He existed before me.' <u>31</u> "I did not recognize Him, but so that He might be manifested to Israel, I came baptizing in water." <u>32</u> John testified saying, "I have seen the Spirit descending as a dove out of heaven, and He remained upon Him.

<u>John 1:33</u> "I did not recognize Him, but **He who sent me** to baptize in water **said to me**, 'He upon whom you see the Spirit descending and remaining upon Him, **this is the One who baptizes in the Holy Spirit.**' <u>34</u> "I myself have seen, **and have testified** that **this is the Son of God.**" <u>35</u> ¶ Again the next day John was standing with two of his disciples, <u>36</u> and he looked at Jesus as He walked, and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God!"

<u>Luke 7:20</u> When the men came to Him, they said, "John the Baptist has sent us to You, to ask, 'Are You the Expected One, or do we look for someone else?"

<u>Luke 7:21</u> At that very time He cured many *people* of diseases and afflictions and evil spirits; and He gave sight to many *who were* blind.

<u>Luke 7:22</u> And He answered and said to them, "Go and report to John what you have seen and heard: *the* BLIND RECEIVE SIGHT, *the* lame walk, *the* lepers are cleansed, and *the* deaf hear, *the* dead are raised up, *the* POOR HAVE THE GOSPEL PREACHED TO THEM.

<u>Isa. 35:5</u> Then the **eyes of the blind** will be opened And the **ears of the deaf** will be unstopped.

- <u>Isa. 61:1, 2</u> 1 ¶ The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, Because the LORD has anointed me To bring good news to the afflicted; He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to captives And freedom to prisoners; 2 To proclaim the favorable year of the LORD And the day of vengeance of our God;

<u>Luke 4:20, 21</u> ¶ And He closed the book, gave it back to the attendant and sat down; and the eyes of all in the synagogue were fixed on Him.

<u>21</u> And He began to say to them, "Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing."

Luke 7:23 "Blessed is he who does not take offense at Me."

<u>Luke 7:24</u> ¶ When the messengers of John had left, **He began to speak to the crowds about John, "What did you go out into the wilderness to see?** A reed shaken by the wind?

<u>Luke 7:25</u> "But what did you go out to see? **A man dressed in soft clothing?** Those who are splendidly clothed and live in luxury are *found* in royal palaces!

<u>Matt. 3:4</u> Now John himself had a garment of camel's hair and a leather belt around his waist; and his **food was locusts and wild honey**.

<u>Luke 7:26</u> "But what did you go out to see? **A prophet?** Yes, I say to you, and one who is **more than a prophet.**

<u>Luke 7:27</u> "This is the one about whom it is written, 'BEHOLD, I SEND MY MESSENGER AHEAD OF YOU, WHO WILL PREPARE YOUR WAY BEFORE YOU.'

<u>Mal. 3:1</u> ¶ "Behold, I am going to send **My messenger**, and he will clear the way **before Me.** And **the Lord,** whom you seek, will suddenly come to His temple; and **the messenger of the covenant**, in whom you delight, behold, He is coming," says the LORD of hosts.

<u>Luke 7:28</u> "I say to you, among those born of women there is no one greater than **John**; yet he who is least in the kingdom of God is greater than he."
