Sunday, November 15, 2020 Sermon Scriptures

Acts 20:17 ¶ From Miletus he sent to Ephesus and called to him the elders of the church.

Acts 20:18, 19 18 And when they had come to him, he said to them, ¶ "You yourselves know, from the first day that I set foot in Asia, how I was with you the whole time,

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<u>19</u> serving the Lord **with all humility** and **with tears** and **with trials** which came upon me through **the plots of the Jews**;

<u>1 Cor. 15:9</u> For I am **the least of the apostles**, and not fit to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.

Eph. 3:8 To me, **the very least of all saints**, this grace was given, to preach to the Gentiles the unfathomable riches of Christ,

<u>Rom. 9:2,3</u> that I have **great sorrow and unceasing grief** in my heart. <u>3</u> For I could wish that I myself were accursed, *separated* from Christ for the sake of my brethren, **my kinsmen** according to the flesh,

<u>2 Cor. 2:4</u> For out of much affliction and anguish of heart I wrote to you with many tears; not so that you would be made sorrowful, but that you might know the love which I have especially for you.

<u>Phil. 3:18</u> For many walk, of whom I often told you, and now tell you even weeping, that they are enemies of the cross of Christ,

Acts 9:23 \ When many days had elapsed, the Jews plotted together to do away with him,

Acts 20:20, 21 20 how I did not shrink from declaring to you anything that was profitable, and teaching you publicly and from house to house,

<u>2Tim. 3:16</u> All Scripture is inspired by God and **profitable** for **teaching**, for **reproof**, for **correction**, for **training in righteousness**;

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<u>21</u> solemnly testifying to **both Jews and Greeks** of **repentance** toward God and **faith in** our **Lord Jesus Christ**.

Rom. 1:14, 16 14 I am under obligation both to Greeks and to barbarians, both to the wise and to the foolish.

<u>16</u> ¶ For I am **not ashamed of the gospel**, for it is the **power of God for salvation** to everyone who believes, to the **Jew first** and also to **the Greek**.

Rom. 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

<u>Isa. 53:6</u> All of us like sheep have gone astray, Each of us has turned to his own way; But the LORD has **caused the iniquity of us all To fall on Him.**

Matt. 20:28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

<u>1 John 2:2</u> and He Himself is **the propitiation for our sins**; and not for ours only, but also for *those of* **the whole world**.

<u>1 Tim. 2:5</u> For there is **one God**, *and* **one mediator** also between God and men, *the* man **Christ Jesus**,

Acts 20:22-24 22 "And now, behold, bound by the Spirit, I am on my way to Jerusalem, not knowing what will happen to me there,

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<u>23</u> except that the Holy Spirit solemnly testifies to me in every city, saying that bonds and afflictions await me.

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<u>24</u> "But I do not consider my life of any account as dear to myself, so that I may finish my course and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify solemnly of the gospel of the grace of God.

Mark 8:35 "For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake and the gospel's will save it.

<u>Heb. 12:1</u> ¶ Therefore, since we have so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us also **lay aside every encumbrance and the sin** which so easily entangles us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, <u>2</u> fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has **sat down at the right hand of the throne of God**.

Eph. 2:8, 9 8 For by grace you have been saved **through faith**; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; **9** not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.

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
