Rom. 1:20, 21 20 For **since the creation of the world** His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse. **21** For even though **they knew God**, they did not honor Him as God **or give thanks**, but they became futile in their speculations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

2 Tim. 3:1-2 1 ¶ But realize this, that **in the last days** difficult times will come. **2** For men will be lovers of self, lovers of money, boastful, arrogant, revilers, disobedient to parents, **ungrateful**, unholy,

Psa. 100:4 ¶ Enter **His gates with thanksgiving** And His courts with praise. Give thanks to Him, bless His name.

Psa. 30:4 Sing praise to the LORD, you His godly ones, **And give thanks** to His holy name.

Heb. 13:15 Through Him then, let us continually offer up **a sacrifice of praise to God**, that is, the fruit of lips **that give thanks** to His name.

Col. 3:15 Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body; **and be thankful**.

Col. 4:2 ¶ **Devote yourselves to prayer**, keeping alert in it with *an attitude of thanksgiving*;

1 Thess. 5:18 **in everything give thanks**; for this is **God's will for you** in Christ Jesus.

Phil. 4:6 Be anxious for nothing, but **in everything** by prayer and supplication **with thanksgiving** let your requests be made known to God.

Rom. 12:15a **Rejoice with those who rejoice**, and weep with those who weep.

Psa. 127:3 ¶ Behold, **children are a gift** of the LORD, The fruit of the womb is a reward.

Eph. 5:20 always **giving thanks for all things** in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to God, even the Father;

Psa. 106:1 ¶ Praise the LORD! **Oh give thanks to the LORD**, for He is good; For His **lovingkindness** is everlasting.

2 Cor. 9:15 **Thanks be to God** for His **indefinable gift!**

John 3:16 ¶ “For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him **shall not perish**, but have **eternal life**.”

1 John 5:11-13 **11** And the testimony is this, that **God has given us eternal life**, and this life is **in His Son**. **12** He who has the Son has the life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have the life. **13** ¶ These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, **so that you may know that you have eternal life**.

Rom. 8:29 For those whom He foreknew, He also **predestined to become conformed to the image of His Son**, so that He would be the firstborn among many brethren;

Phil. 3:21 who will transform the body of our humble state **into conformity with the body of His glory**, by the exertion of the power that He has even to subject all things to Himself.

1 Cor. 3:14 If any man’s work which he has built on it remains, **he will receive a reward**.

Rev. 22:12 ¶ “Behold, I am coming quickly, and **My reward is with Me**, to render to every man according to what he has done.

1 Cor. 15:26, 54, 55 **26** The last enemy that **will be abolished is death**. **54** But when this perishable will have put on the imperishable, and this mortal will have put on immortality, then will come about the saying that is written, “**DEATH IS SWALLOWED UP in victory**.” **55** “O DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR VICTORY? O DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR STING?”

2 Tim. 1:10 but now has been revealed by the appearing of our Savior Christ Jesus, who **abolished death** and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel,

Heb. 12:23 to the general assembly and church of the firstborn who are enrolled in heaven, and to God, the Judge of all, and to **the spirits of the righteous made perfect**,

Rom. 14:17 for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but **righteousness and peace and joy** in the Holy Spirit.

Rev. 21:4, 5 4 and He will wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there will **no longer be any death**; there will no longer be *any* mourning, or crying, or pain; **the first things have passed away.** 5 ¶ And He who sits on the throne said, “**Behold, I am making all things new.**” And He said, “Write, for these words are faithful and true.”

Matt. 6:25, 30-33 ¶ “For this reason I say to you, do not be worried about your life, *as to* what you will **eat or what you will drink; nor for your body**, *as to* what you will put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? 30 “But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which is *alive* today and tomorrow is thrown into the furnace, **will He not much more clothe you?** You of little faith! 31 “**Do not worry** then, saying, ‘What will we eat?’ or ‘What will we drink?’ or ‘What will we wear for clothing?’ 32 “For the Gentiles eagerly seek all these things; for **your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things.** 33 “But **seek first** His kingdom and His righteousness, and **all these things will be added to you.**

Phil. 4:19 And my **God will supply all your needs** according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

Psa. 34:19 ¶ Many are **the afflictions** of the righteous, But **the LORD delivers him** out of them all.

2 Thess. 1:4 therefore, we ourselves speak proudly of you among the churches of God for **your perseverance and faith** in the midst of all your **persecutions and afflictions** which **you endure.**

Rom. 5:3 And not only this, but **we also exult in our tribulations**, knowing that **tribulation brings about perseverance;**

Psa. 145:9 The LORD is good to all, And His **mercies** are over all His works.
