Sunday, November 29, 2020 Sermon Scriptures

- Gen. 2:18, 22-25 18 ¶ Then the LORD God said, "It is **not good** for the man to be alone; I will make him a **helper suitable** for him." 22 The LORD God **fashioned** into a woman the rib which He had taken from the man, and brought her to the man. 23 The man said, "This is now bone of my bones, And flesh of my flesh; She shall be called Woman, Because she was taken out of Man." 24 For this reason a man shall leave his father and his mother, and be joined to his wife; and they shall become one flesh. 25 And the man and his wife were both naked and were not ashamed.
- Gen. 1:27, 28 27 God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. 28 God blessed them; and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it; and rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over every living thing that moves on the earth."
- <u>Matt. 19:4, 5</u> <u>4</u> And He answered and said, "Have you not read that He who created *them* from **the beginning MADE THEM MALE AND FEMALE**, <u>5</u> and said, 'FOR THIS REASON A MAN SHALL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND MOTHER AND BE JOINED TO HIS WIFE, AND **THE TWO SHALL BECOME ONE FLESH'?**
- Gen. 2:18 ¶ Then the LORD God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone; I will make him a helper suitable for him."
- <u>Matt. 19:6-8</u> <u>6</u> "So they are no longer two, but one flesh. What therefore **God has joined together**, **let no man separate**." <u>7</u> They said to Him, "Why then did Moses command to GIVE HER A CERTIFICATE OF DIVORCE AND SEND *her* AWAY?" <u>8</u> He said to them, "Because of your hardness of heart Moses permitted you to divorce your wives; but from the beginning it has not been this way.
- Gen. 4:1, 2 1 ¶ Now the man had relations with his wife Eve, and she conceived and gave birth to Cain, and she said, "I have gotten a manchild with the help of the LORD." 2 Again, she gave birth to his brother Abel. And Abel was a keeper of flocks, but Cain was a tiller of the ground.
- **Eph. 6:1-3 1** ¶ **Children, obey your parents** in the Lord, for this is right. **2** HONOR **YOUR FATHER AND MOTHER** (which is the first commandment with a promise), **3** SO THAT IT MAY BE WELL WITH YOU, AND THAT YOU MAY LIVE LONG ON THE EARTH.

- **2** Cor. 6:14, 15 14 ¶ Do not be bound together with unbelievers; for what partnership have righteousness and lawlessness, or what fellowship has light with darkness? 15 Or what harmony has Christ with Belial, or what has a believer in common with an unbeliever?

- <u>1 Cor. 6:18</u> Flee immorality. Every *other* sin that a man commits is outside the body, but the immoral man sins against his own body.
- <u>1 Cor. 6:19, 20</u> <u>19</u> Or do you not know that **your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit** who is in you, whom you have from God, and that **you are not your own?** <u>20</u> For you have been bought with a price: **therefore glorify God in your body**.
- <u>1 Thess. 4:3-8</u> <u>3</u> For this is the will of God, your sanctification; that is, that you abstain from sexual immorality; <u>4</u> that each of you know how to possess his own vessel in sanctification and honor, <u>5</u> not in lustful passion, like the Gentiles who do not know God; <u>6</u> and that no man transgress and defraud his brother in the matter because the Lord is the avenger in all these things, just as we also told you before and solemnly warned you. <u>7</u> For God has not called us for the purpose of impurity, but in sanctification. <u>8</u> So, he who rejects this is not rejecting man but the God who gives His Holy Spirit to you.
- <u>1 John 1:5, 6, 9</u> <u>5</u> ¶ This is the message we have heard from Him and announce to you, that God is Light, and **in Him there is no darkness at all.** <u>6</u> If we say that we have fellowship with Him and *yet* **walk in the darkness, we lie** and do not practice the truth; <u>9</u> If we **confess our sins**, He is faithful and righteous **to forgive us our sins** and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- <u>1 John 2:1</u> ¶ My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous;
- Eph. 5:22-24 22 ¶ Wives, be subject to your own husbands, as to the Lord.

 23 For the husband is the head of the wife, as Christ also is the head of the church, He Himself being the Savior of the body.

 24 But as the church is subject to Christ, so also the wives ought to be to their husbands in everything.
- Col. 3:18 ¶ Wives, be subject to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord.
- <u>1 Pet. 3:1-6</u> <u>1</u> ¶ In the same way, **you wives, be submissive to your own husbands** so that even if any *of them* are disobedient to the word, they **may be won without a word** by the **behavior of their wives**, <u>2</u> as they observe **your chaste and respectful behavior**. <u>3</u> Your adornment must not be *merely* external braiding the hair, and wearing gold jewelry, or putting on dresses; <u>4</u> but *let it be* **the hidden person of the heart,** with the imperishable quality of a gentle and quiet spirit, **which is precious in the**

sight of God.

<u>1 Pet. 3:5</u> For in this way **in former times** the holy women also, who hoped in God, used to adorn themselves, **being submissive to their own husbands**; <u>6</u> just as Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him lord, and you have become her children if you do what is right without being frightened by any fear.

Eph. 5:25, 28, 29, 33 25 ¶ Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her, 28 So husbands ought also to love their own wives as their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself; 29 for no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ also *does* the church, 33 Nevertheless, each individual among you also is to love his own wife even as himself, and the wife must *see to it* that she respects her husband.

Col. 3:19 Husbands, love your wives and do not be embittered against them.

<u>1 Pet. 3:7</u> ¶ You husbands in the same way, live with your wives in an understanding way, as with someone weaker, since she is a woman; and show her honor as a fellow heir of the grace of life, so that your prayers will not be hindered.
