<u>Matt. 20:28</u> just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

Matt. 20:20-28 20 ¶ Then the mother of the sons of Zebedee came to Jesus with her sons, bowing down and making a request of Him. 21 And He said to her, "What do you wish?" She said to Him, "Command that in Your kingdom these two sons of mine may sit one on Your right and one on Your left." 22 But Jesus answered, "You do not know what you are asking. Are you able to drink the cup that I am about to drink?" They said to Him, "We are able." 23 He said to them, "My cup you shall drink; but to sit on My right and on My left, this is not Mine to give, but it is for those for whom it has been prepared by My Father." 24 ¶ And hearing this, the ten became indignant 25 But Jesus called them to Himself and said, "You know that with the two brothers. the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and *their* great men exercise authority over 26 "It is not this way among you, but whoever wishes to become great among them. 27 and whoever wishes to be first among you shall be you shall be your servant, your slave; 28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

<u>1 Tim. 2:5, 6</u> For there is **one God**, *and* **one mediator** also between God and men, *the* **man Christ Jesus, <u>6</u> who gave Himself as a ransom** for all, the testimony *given* at **the proper time**.

<u>**1** John 2:2</u> and He Himself is the **propitiation for our sins**; and not for ours only, but also **for** *those of* **the whole world**.

<u>John 3:16</u> ¶ "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

Eph. 2:4, 5, 8 <u>4</u> But God, being rich in mercy, because of **His great love with which He loved us**, <u>5</u> even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (**by grace** you have been saved), <u>8</u> For **by grace you have been saved** through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God;

John 4:10 Jesus answered and said to her, "If you knew the gift of God, and who it is who says to you, 'Give Me a drink,' you would have asked Him, and He would have given you living water."

<u>Rom. 6:23</u> For the wages of sin is death, but **the free gift of God** is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
