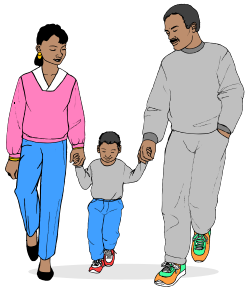
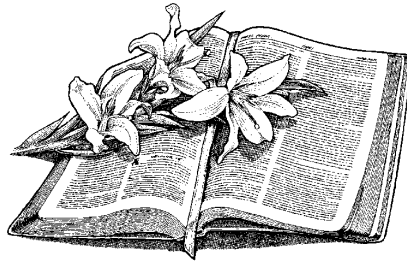

- 2 Cor. 4:7-18, and Others -

“All To The Glory Of God!”

1 Cor. 10:31 ¶ So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.

I. GOD ENTRUSTED PAUL WITH HIS MINISTRY, v-1

- A. “This Ministry” Is The New Covenant Ministry, v-1a; 1 Tim. 1:11, 12
- B. He Received Mercy From God, v-1b; 1 Tim. 1:13
- C. He Did Not Lose Heart, v-1c; Cf. Lk. 18:1
--“He never quit” --Cf. 2 Cor. 1:8

II. PAUL GAVE GOD A SEPARATED AND OBEDIENT LIFE AS HIS SERVANT, v-2

- A. He Renounced Disgraceful And Underhanded Ways, v-2a
- B. He Refused To Practice Cunning Or To Tamper With God’s Word, v-2b
- C. Paul Preached The Gospel Boldly And Truthfully, v-2c; Cf. Rom. 1:16

III. TO SOME PEOPLE PAUL’S GOSPEL MESSAGE WAS VEILED, v-3, 4

- A. It Was Veiled To The Lost, v-3
- B. Satan Blinds Lost People So They Cannot See That Jesus Christ Really Is God, v-4

IV. PAUL AFFIRMED THAT HE WAS NOT PREACHING HIMSELF, BUT CHRIST, v-5, 6

- A. He Did Not Preach Himself, v-5a
- B. He Preached Jesus Christ As Lord, v-5b; Rom. 10:9; Phil. 2:10, 11
- C. Paul Was God’s Servant To Them For Christ’s Sake, v-5c
- D. God Called Light Into Existence In The Creation, v-6a
- E. God Also Gave Spiritual Light To Some So That They Could See God’s Glory In Christ, v-6b
