Sunday, January 17, 2021 Sermon Scriptures

<u>2 Cor. 4:7</u> ¶ But we have **this treasure in earthen vessels**, so that the surpassing greatness of the power will be **of God and not from ourselves**;

2 Cor. 4:8, 9 8 we are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not despairing; 9 persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed;

<u>Matt. 28:20</u> teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

<u>Heb. 13:5</u> *Make sure that* your character is free from the love of money, being content with what you have; for He Himself has said, "I WILL NEVER DESERT YOU, NOR WILL I EVER FORSAKE YOU,"

<u>2 Cor. 11:25</u> Three times I was beaten with rods, once I was stoned, three times I was shipwrecked, a night and a day I have spent in the deep.

<u>2 Cor. 4:10</u> always carrying about in the body the dying of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our body.

Gal. 6:17 ¶ From now on let no one cause me trouble, **for I bear on my body the marks of Jesus.** ESV

Acts 9:16 for I will show him how much he must suffer for My name's sake."

<u>2 Cor. 4:11</u> For we who live are **constantly being delivered over to death** for Jesus' sake, **so that the life of Jesus** also may be manifested **in our mortal flesh**.

<u>1 Cor. 4:9</u> For, I think, God has exhibited us apostles last of all, as men condemned to death; because we have become a spectacle to the world, both to angels and to men.

Eph. 1:12 to the end that we **who were the first to hope in Christ** would be to the **praise of His glory**.

2 Cor. 4:12 So death works in us, but life in you.

<u>2 Cor. 4:13</u> ¶ But having the **same spirit of faith**, according to what is written, "I BELIEVED, THEREFORE I SPOKE," **we also believe, therefore we also speak**,

- <u>Psa. 116:1-4, 7-10 1</u> ¶ I love the LORD, because He hears My voice *and* my supplications. <u>2</u> Because He has inclined His ear to me, Therefore I shall call *upon Him* as long as I live. <u>3</u> The cords of death encompassed me And the terrors of Sheol came upon me; I found distress and sorrow.
- Psa. 116:4 Then I called upon the name of the LORD: "O LORD, I beseech You, save my life!"

 7 Return to your rest, O my soul, For the LORD has dealt bountifully with you.

 8 For You have rescued my soul from death, My eyes from tears, My feet from stumbling.

 9 I shall walk before the LORD In the land of the living.

 10 I believed when I said, "I am greatly afflicted."
- <u>2 Cor. 1:5, 6</u> 5 For just as the **sufferings of Christ are ours in abundance**, so also **our comfort is abundant** through Christ. <u>6</u> But if we are afflicted, **it is for your comfort and salvation**; or **if we are comforted, it is for your comfort**, which is effective in **the patient enduring** of the **same sufferings** which we also suffer;
- <u>2 Cor. 4:14</u> knowing that **He who raised the Lord Jesus** will **raise us also** with Jesus and **will present us with you**.

- <u>2 Cor. 4:15</u> For all things *are* for your sakes, so that the grace which is spreading to more and more people may cause the giving of thanks to abound to the glory of God.
- $\underline{2\ Cor.\ 4:16}\ \P$ Therefore we do not lose heart, but though our outer man is decaying, yet our inner man is being renewed day by day.
- <u>2 Cor. 4:17</u> For momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison,
- <u>2 Cor. 4:18</u> while we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen; for the things which are seen are temporal, but the things which are not seen are eternal.
- <u>1 John 2:17</u> The world is passing away, and *also* its lusts; but the one who does the will of God lives forever.
