<u>Matt. 12:32</u> "Whoever speaks a word against the Son of Man, it shall be forgiven him; but whoever speaks against the Holy Spirit, it shall not be forgiven him, either in this age or in the *age* to come.

Acts 26:11 "And as I punished them often in all the synagogues, I tried to force them to blaspheme; and being furiously enraged at them, I kept pursuing them even to foreign cities.

<u>**1** Tim. 1:13</u> even though **I was formerly a blasphemer** and a persecutor and a violent aggressor. Yet I was **shown mercy because I acted ignorantly** in unbelief;

Mark 3:29, 30 29 but whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit never has forgiveness, but is guilty of an eternal sin" — <u>30</u> because they were saying, "He has an unclean spirit."

<u>Mark 3:22</u> The scribes who came down from Jerusalem were saying, "He is **possessed by Beelzebul,**" and "He casts out the demons by the ruler of the demons."

<u>Matt. 7:21-23</u> 21 ¶ "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven *will enter*.

<u>Matt. 7:22</u> "Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?'

<u>23</u> "And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; DEPART FROM ME, YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS.'

<u>2 Tim. 3:13</u> But evil men and impostors will proceed *from bad* to worse, deceiving and being deceived.

Matt. 12:33 ¶ "Either make the tree good and its fruit good, or make the tree bad and its fruit bad; for the tree is known by its fruit.

<u>Luke 6:43, 44</u> <u>43</u> "For there is **no good tree which produces bad fruit**, **nor**, on the other hand, **a bad tree which produces good fruit**. <u>44</u> "For **each tree is known by its own fruit**. For men do not gather figs from thorns, nor do they pick grapes from a briar bush.

**John 3:1,2** 1 ¶ Now there was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews; 2 this man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know that You have come from God *as* a teacher; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him."

<u>Matt. 3:7</u> ¶ But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees coming for baptism, he said to them, "You brood of vipers, who warned you to flee from the wrath to come?

<u>Matt. 12:34</u> "You brood of vipers, how can you, being evil, speak what is good? For the mouth speaks out of that which fills the heart.

<u>Matt. 23:15</u> ¶ "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites, because you travel around on sea and land to make one proselyte; and when he becomes one, you make him twice as much a son of hell as yourselves.

Matt. 12:35 "The good man brings out of *his* good treasure what is good; and the evil man brings out of *his* evil treasure what is evil.

<u>Luke 6:45</u> "The good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth what is good; and the evil *man* out of the evil *treasure* brings forth what is evil; for his mouth speaks from that which fills his heart.

**<u>Prov. 4:23</u>** Watch over your heart with all diligence, For from it *flow* the springs of life.

<u>Matt. 12:36</u> "But I tell you that every careless word that people speak, they shall give an accounting for it in the day of judgment.

<u>Matt. 12:37</u> "For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned."

<u>James 3:5, 6</u> 5 So also the tongue is a small part of the body, and *yet* it boasts of great things. ¶ See how great a forest is set aflame by such a small fire! <u>6</u> And the tongue is a fire, the *very* world of iniquity; the tongue is set among our members as that which defiles the entire body, and sets on fire the course of *our* life, and is set on fire by hell.

**<u>Prov. 12:18</u>** There is one who speaks rashly like the thrusts of a sword, But **the tongue of the wise brings healing**.
