Sermon Scriptures

Matt. 12:31 ¶ “Therefore I say to you, **any sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven people**, but **blasphemy against the Spirit shall not be forgiven**.

Mark 3:28 ¶ “Truly I say to you, **all sins shall be forgiven** the sons of men, and whatever blasphemies they utter;

Acts 10:38 “*You know of Jesus of Nazareth, how **God anointed Him with the Holy Spirit** and with power, and *how* He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, **for God was with Him**.*

=====

Matt. 12:32 “Whoever speaks a word against the Son of Man, it shall be forgiven him; but whoever speaks against the Holy Spirit, it shall not be forgiven him, either in this age or in the *age* to come.

Acts 26:11 “And as I punished them often in all the synagogues, **I tried to force them to blaspheme**; and being furiously enraged at them, I kept pursuing them even to foreign cities.

1 Tim. 1:13 even though **I was formerly a blasphemer** and a persecutor and a violent aggressor. Yet I was **shown mercy because I acted ignorantly** in unbelief;

Mark 3:29, 30 **29** but **whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit never** has forgiveness, but is guilty of **an eternal sin**” — **30** because they were saying, “He has an unclean spirit.”

Mark 3:22 **The scribes** who came down from Jerusalem were saying, “**He is possessed by Beelzebul**,” and “He casts out the demons by the ruler of the demons.”

Matt. 7:21-23 **21** ¶ “**Not everyone** who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ **will enter the kingdom of heaven**, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven *will enter*.

Matt. 7:22 “Many will say to Me on that day, ‘Lord, Lord, **did we not prophesy** in Your name, and in Your name **cast out demons**, and in Your name **perform many miracles?**’

23 “And then **I will declare to them, ‘I never knew you; DEPART FROM ME, YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS.’**

2 Tim. 3:13 But **evil men and impostors** will proceed *from bad to worse*, **deceiving and being deceived.**

Matt. 12:33 ¶ “Either **make the tree good** and its fruit good, or **make the tree bad** and its fruit bad; for **the tree is known by its fruit.**

Luke 6:43, 44 **43** “For there is **no good tree which produces bad fruit, nor**, on the other hand, **a bad tree which produces good fruit.** **44** “For **each tree is known by its own fruit.** For men do not gather figs from thorns, nor do they pick grapes from a briar bush.

John 3:1, 2 **1** ¶ Now there was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews; **2** this man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, “Rabbi, **we know that You have come from God** *as* a teacher; **for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him.**”

Matt. 3:7 ¶ But **when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees** coming for baptism, he said to them, “**You brood of vipers**, who warned you to flee from the wrath to come?

Matt. 12:34 “**You brood of vipers**, how can you, **being evil, speak what is good?** For the mouth speaks **out of that which fills the heart.**

Matt. 23:15 ¶ “**Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites**, because you travel around on sea and land to make one proselyte; and when he becomes one, **you make him twice as much a son of hell as yourselves.**

Matt. 12:35 “The **good man** brings out of *his* **good treasure** what is good; and the **evil man** brings out of *his* **evil treasure** what is evil.

Luke 6:45 “The **good man** out of the **good treasure of his heart** brings forth what is good; and the **evil man** out of the **evil treasure** brings forth what is evil; for his mouth speaks from that which fills his heart.

Prov. 4:23 **Watch over your heart** with all diligence, For from it *flow* **the springs of life.**

Matt. 12:36 “But I tell you that **every careless word** that people speak, they shall give **an accounting for it** in the day of judgment.

Matt. 12:37 “For **by your words** you will **be justified**, and **by your words** you will **be condemned.**”

James 3:5, 6 **5** So also **the tongue** is a small part of the body, and *yet* it boasts of great things. ¶ See how great a forest is set aflame by such a small fire! **6** And the **tongue is a fire**, the *very world of iniquity*; the tongue is set among our members as that which **defiles the entire body**, and sets on fire the course of *our* life, and is **set on fire by hell.**

Prov. 12:18 There is one who speaks rashly like the thrusts of a sword, **But the tongue of the wise brings healing.**
