- It is one of the Prison Epistles, written from prison, Acts 28:16, 30; Philemon 1:9

II. PAUL GREETES THE CHURCH, Col. 1:1-4

- He Makes Mention Of His Apostleship, v-1a
- His Fellow Worker Timothy Is With Him, v-1b
- He Expresses God's Desire For Them, v-2
- He Expresses His Thanks To God And His Prayer For them, v-3, 4

III. PAUL EXPRESSES THE CONTENT OF HIS PRAYERS FOR THE CHURCH

- Epaphras Told Paul About The Church, v-7, 8
- His Prayer Is That They Might Have Full Knowledge Of God's Will, v-9
- That They Be Pleasing To God, v-10, 11
- That They Might Joyously Give Thanks To God For His Great Salvation In Christ, v-12-14
- That They Really Know Who Christ Is, v-15-20

- (2) Genuine Christians who are prejudice are destroying their reward, 2 Cor. 5:10

B. James Wrote To Scattered Jewish Believers (45-49 A.D.) --Key Leader of the Church of Jerusalem, Acts 15:12, 13, 19, 22

1. He spoke against Gossip and Slander among them, Jam. 3:7-10
2. James warned the Church against Worldliness, Jam. 4:1-4
3. John also warned against loving the world, 1 John 2:15-17
4. Paul warned that people would not be lovers of God today, 2 Tim. 3:1-5

C. The Churches Of Galatia (49 AD)

“The Churches Of Galatia, Deceived With Another Gospel!”

--They allowed Jewish False Teachers to come among them and move them away from all that Paul taught them. Gal. 1:1-9, 11, 12, 16, 20

1. Paul Defends The Source of his Ministry And Gospel
 - a. He was made an Apostle by God, v-1-3
 - b. The Death of Jesus Christ for our sins is the essence of the true Gospel, v-4,5
 - c. Paul expresses his amazement that they have so quickly moved away from God's Truth, v-6,7
 - d. Paul shows how serious this departure from God's truth is, v-8,9
2. Paul affirms again that his Gospel is from God, v-11, 12, 16, 20
3. Paul points out how foolish the Galatians are to not recognize that the Gospel is based upon faith and not the Law, Gal. 3:1-9
