<u>Col. 2:8-10</u> ¶ See to it that no one takes you **captive** through **philosophy** and **empty deception**, according to the **tradition of men**, according to the **elementary principles of the world**, **rather than** according to Christ.

9 For in Him all the **fullness of Deity dwells in bodily form**,

<u>Col. 2:10</u> and in Him you have been made complete, and He is the head over all rule and authority;

Rom. 4:3, 11 3 For what does the Scripture say? "ABRAHAM BELIEVED GOD, AND IT WAS CREDITED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS." 11 and he received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the faith which he had while uncircumcised, so that he might be the father of all who believe without being circumcised, that righteousness might be credited to them,

<u>Col. 1:16</u> For by Him all things were created, *both* in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities — all things have been created through Him and for Him.

<u>Col. 2:11</u> and in Him you were also circumcised with a circumcision made without hands, in the removal of the body of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ;

Rom. 2:28 For he is not a Jew who is one outwardly, nor is circumcision that which is outward in the flesh. **29** But he is a Jew **who is one inwardly**; and **circumcision is that which is of the heart**, by the Spirit, not by the letter; and his praise is not from men, but from God.

<u>Col. 2:16, 17</u> ¶ Therefore no one is to act as your judge in regard **to food or drink** or in respect to **a festival** or a **new moon** or **a Sabbath day** — <u>17</u> things which are a *mere* **shadow** of what is to come; but **the substance belongs to Christ**.

<u>Col. 2:18</u> Let **no one keep defrauding you** of **your prize** by delighting in **self-abasement** and the **worship of the angels**, taking his stand **on** *visions* **he has seen**, inflated without cause by **his fleshly mind**,

<u>Col. 2:20-23</u> ¶ If you have died with Christ to the elementary principles of the world, why, as if you were living in the world, do you submit yourself to decrees, such as, 21 "Do not handle, do not taste, do not touch!"

<u>Col. 2:22</u> (which all *refer to* things destined to perish with use) — in accordance with **the commandments and teachings of men?** <u>23</u> These are matters which have, to be sure, the **appearance of wisdom** in **self-made religion** and **self-abasement** and **severe treatment of the body**, *but are* of **no value against fleshly indulgence.**

<u>Col. 2:18</u> Let **no one keep defrauding you** of **your prize** by delighting in **self-abasement** and the **worship of the angels**, taking his stand **on** *visions* **he has seen**, inflated without cause by **his fleshly mind**,

Rev. 22:8, 9 8 ¶ I, John, am the one who heard and saw these things. And when I heard and saw, I fell down to worship at the feet of the angel who showed me these things. 9 But he said to me, "Do not do that. I am a fellow servant of yours and of your brethren the prophets and of those who heed the words of this book. Worship God."

<u>2 John 7, 8</u> ¶ For **many deceivers** have gone out into the world, those who do not acknowledge Jesus Christ *as* coming in the flesh. This is **the deceiver** and the **antichrist**.

<u>8</u> Watch yourselves, that you do not lose what we have accomplished, but that you may receive a full reward.
