EASTER Sunday, April 4, 2021 Sermon Scriptures

Matt. 16:21 ¶ From that time Jesus began to show His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem, and suffer many things from the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised up on the third day.

Matt. 12:39 But He answered and said to them, "An evil and adulterous generation craves for a sign; and yet no sign will be given to it but the sign of Jonah the prophet;

<u>Luke 18:31-34</u> ¶ Then He took the twelve aside and said to them, "Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and all things which are written through the prophets about the Son of Man will be accomplished. <u>32</u> "For He will be handed over to the Gentiles, and will be mocked and mistreated and spit upon, <u>33</u> and after they have scourged Him, they will kill Him; and the third day He will rise again." <u>34</u> But the disciples understood none of these things, and the meaning of this statement was hidden from them, and they did not comprehend the things that were said.

<u>Luke 23:55, 56</u> 55 Now the women who had come with Him out of Galilee followed, and saw the tomb and how His body was laid. 56 Then they returned and prepared spices and perfumes. ¶ And on the Sabbath they rested according to the commandment.

<u>Luke 24:1-9</u> 1 ¶ But on the **first day of the week**, at early dawn, they came to the tomb bringing the spices which they had prepared. 2 And they found the stone rolled away from the tomb, 3 but when they entered, **they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus.** 4 While they **were perplexed about this**, behold, two men suddenly stood near them in **dazzling clothing**; 5 and as **the women were terrified and bowed their faces** to the ground, **the men** said to them, "Why do you seek the living One among the dead? 6 "He is not here, but He has risen. Remember how He spoke to you while He was still in Galilee, 7 saying that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, **and the third day rise again.**" 8 And they remembered His words, 9 and returned from the tomb and **reported all these things to the eleven and to all the rest.**

<u>Luke 24:10, 11</u> Now they were Mary Magdalene and Joanna and Mary the *mother* of James; also the other women with them were **telling these things to the apostles**.

<u>11</u> But these words appeared to them as nonsense, and they would not believe them.

<u>Luke 24:36-40 36</u> ¶ While they were telling these things, **He Himself stood in their midst** and said to them, "Peace be to you." <u>37</u> But they were startled and frightened and **thought that they were seeing a spirit**. <u>38</u> And He said to them, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your hearts?

<u>Luke 24:39</u> "See My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself; touch Me and see, for a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have." <u>40</u> And when He had said this, He showed them His hands and His feet.

Luke 24:41-49 41 While they still could not believe *it* because of their joy and amazement, He said to them, "Have you anything here to eat?" **42** They gave Him a piece of a broiled fish; 43 and He took it and ate it before them. 44 ¶ Now He said to them, "These are My words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things which are written about Me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms must be fulfilled." 45 Then He opened their minds to understand the 46 and He said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ would suffer and rise again from the dead the third day, 47 and that repentance for forgiveness of sins would be proclaimed in His name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. **48** "You are witnesses of these things. 49 "And behold, I am sending forth the promise of My Father upon you; but you are to stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high."

Acts 1:1-3 1 ¶ The first account I composed, Theophilus, about all that Jesus began to do and teach, 2 until the day when He was taken up *to heaven*, after He had by the Holy Spirit given orders to the apostles whom He had chosen. 3 To these He also presented Himself alive after His suffering, by many convincing proofs, appearing to them over *a period of* forty days and speaking of the things concerning the kingdom of God.

<u>1 Cor. 15:3, 4, 6</u> <u>3</u> ¶ For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, <u>4</u> and that He was buried, and that **He was raised on the third day** according to the Scriptures, <u>6</u> After that He appeared **to more than five hundred brethren at one time**, most of whom remain until now, but some have fallen asleep;

<u>John 5:18</u> For this reason therefore the Jews were seeking all the more to kill Him, because He not only was breaking the Sabbath, but also was calling God His own Father, making Himself equal with God.

<u>John 8:56-59</u> <u>56</u> "Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, and he saw *it* and was glad." <u>57</u> So the Jews said to Him, "You are not yet fifty years old, and have You seen Abraham?" <u>58</u> Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I am." <u>59</u> Therefore they picked up stones to throw at Him, but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple.

<u>John 6:38</u>. "For I have **come down from heaven**, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.

John 14:7-11 7 "If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; from now on you know Him, and have seen Him." 8 ¶ Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us." 9 Jesus said to him, "Have I been so long with you, and yet you have not come to know Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; how can you say, 'Show us the Father'? 10 "Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father is in Me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on My own initiative, but the Father abiding in Me does His works.

11 "Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father is in Me; otherwise believe because of the works themselves.

John 5:22-27 22 "For not even the Father judges anyone, but He has given all judgment to the Son, 23 so that all will honor the Son even as they honor the Father. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent Him. 24 ¶ "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life. 25 "Truly, truly, I say to you, an hour is coming and now is, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God, and those who hear will live. 26 "For just as the Father has life in Himself, even so He gave to the Son also to have life in Himself; 27 and He gave Him authority to execute judgment, because He is the Son of Man.

<u>John 5:28, 29</u> <u>28</u> "Do not marvel at this; for an hour is coming, in which **all who are** in the tombs will hear His voice, <u>29</u> and will come forth; those who did the good *deeds* to a resurrection of life, those who committed the evil *deeds* to a resurrection of judgment.

John 11:23-27 23 Jesus said to her, "Your brother will rise again." 24 Martha said to Him, "I know that he will rise again in the resurrection on the last day."

25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies, 26 and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die. Do you believe this?" 27 She said to Him, "Yes, Lord; I have believed that You are the Christ, the Son of God, even He who comes into the world."

<u>John 14:6</u> Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

John 6:37, 39 37 "All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will certainly not cast out. 39 "This is the will of Him who sent Me, that of all that He has given Me I lose nothing, but raise it up on the last day.

Matt. 20:28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

<u>Rom. 4:25</u> *He* who was **delivered over because of our transgressions**, and was raised because of our justification.

<u>Isa. 53:5, 6, 11, 12 5</u> But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; The chastening for our well-being *fell* upon Him, And by His scourging we are healed. <u>6</u> All of us like sheep have gone astray, Each of us has turned to his own way; But the LORD has caused the iniquity of us all To fall on Him. <u>11</u> As a result of the anguish of His soul, He will see *it and* be satisfied; By His knowledge the Righteous One, My Servant, will justify the many, As He will bear their iniquities. <u>12</u> Therefore, I will allot Him a portion with the great, And He will divide the booty with the strong; Because He poured out Himself to death, And was numbered with the transgressors; Yet He Himself bore the sin of many, And interceded for the transgressors.

<u>Rom. 5:18</u> ¶ So then as through **one transgression there resulted condemnation** to all men, even so through one act of righteousness there **resulted justification of life** to all men.

Rom. 8:1 \P Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

<u>Phil. 3:20, 21</u> <u>20</u> For our citizenship is in heaven, from which also we eagerly wait for a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ; <u>21</u> who will transform the body of our humble state into conformity with the body of His glory, by the exertion of the power that He has even to subject all things to Himself.

- <u>1 Thess. 4:14-17</u> <u>14</u> For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who have fallen asleep in Jesus. <u>15</u> For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord, will not precede those who have fallen asleep. <u>16</u> For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of *the* archangel and with the trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. <u>17</u> Then we who are alive and remain will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we shall always be with the Lord.
- 1 Cor. 15:49-58 49 Just as we have borne the image of the earthy, we will also bear the image of the heavenly. 50 ¶ Now I say this, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable.

 51 Behold, I tell you a mystery; we will not all sleep, but we will all be changed, 52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet; for the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed. 53 For this perishable must put on the imperishable, and this mortal must put on immortality.

 54 But when this perishable will have put on the imperishable, and this mortal will have put on immortality, then will come about the saying that is written, "DEATH IS SWALLOWED UP in victory.

<u>1 Cor. 15:55</u> "O DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR VICTORY? O DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR STING?"

- **<u>56</u>** The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law;
- <u>57</u> but thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
- <u>58</u> ¶ Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your toil is not in vain in the Lord.
