- D. Someone Let The Lord Know That His Family Was Standing Outside Waiting To See Him, Mt. 12:47; Lk. 8:20
- II. THEY PROBABLY CAME TO RESCUE HIM
  - A. From His Hectic Schedule, Cf. Mk. 3:20, 21
  - B. His Brothers Had Not Become Believers Yet, Jn. 7:5
- III. THE LORD RESPONDS TO THE MESSENGER, Mt. 12:48-50
  - A. He Takes The Opportunity To Teach A Spiritual Lesson With A Question, v-48
    - 1. He was not putting down family relationships.
    - 2. He was highlighting a far deeper issue--"People in relationship with Him."
    - (a) The Messenger and the Crowd probably were expecting the Lord to stop and see about them.
    - (b) The Brothers were not even believers
    - (c) The Nation needed to be in a relationship with Him, Jn. 8:24

- (d) The question really was "Who are the sort of people who are My Mother and Brothers?"
- B. The Lord Answers The Question By Pointing To His Disciples, v-49a
  - 1. They were sitting around listening to Him
  - 2. They were believing He was God sent.
- C. The Lord Defines Those Who Have A Real Relationship With Him, v-49b
  - 1. They are those who do the will of God, Mt. 12:50; Mk. 3:35
  - 2. Specifically, those who obey God's Word, Lk. 8:21. Cf. Mt. 7:21; Lk. 11:27, 28
    - -- James, who believed on Christ after His resurrection, emphasized this very point, 1 Cor. 15:7; Gal. 1:19; James 1:22
  - 3. The Lord had stated the Father's Will to the Nation, Jn. 6:40; Jn. 6:27-29; 14:21
