Matt. 10:34-37 34 ¶ "Do not think that I came to bring peace on the earth; I did not come to bring peace, but a sword. 35 "For I came to SET A MAN AGAINST HIS FATHER, AND A DAUGHTER AGAINST HER MOTHER, AND A DAUGHTER-IN-LAW AGAINST HER MOTHER-IN-LAW; 36 and A MAN'S ENEMIES WILL BE THE MEMBERS OF HIS HOUSEHOLD. 37 ¶ "He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me; and he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.

<u>Matt. 1:18</u> ¶ Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows: when His mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, **before they came together** she was found to be **with child by the Holy Spirit.** 

Matt. 1:25 but kept her a virgin until she gave birth to a Son; and he called His name Jesus.

<u>Luke 2:7</u> And she gave birth to her firstborn son; and she wrapped Him in cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.

Matt. 13:53-57 53 ¶ When Jesus had finished these parables, He departed from there. 54 He came to His hometown and began teaching them in their synagogue, so that they were astonished, and said, "Where did this man get this wisdom and these miraculous powers? 55 "Is not this the carpenter's son? Is not His mother called Mary, and His brothers, James and Joseph and Simon and Judas? 56 "And His sisters, are they not all with us? Where then did this man get all these things?" 57 And they took offense at Him. But Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without honor except in his hometown and in his own household."

Matt. 12:46 ¶ While He was still speaking to the crowds, behold, His mother and brothers were standing outside, seeking to speak to Him.

<u>Luke 8:19</u> ¶ And His mother and brothers came to Him, and they were **unable to get to Him because of the crowd.**

<u>Mark 3:32</u> A crowd was sitting around Him, and they said to Him, "Behold, Your mother and Your brothers are outside looking for You."

<u>Matt. 12:47</u> Someone said to Him, "Behold, Your mother and Your brothers are standing outside seeking to speak to You."

<u>Luke 8:20</u> And it was reported to Him, "Your mother and Your brothers are standing outside, wishing to see You."

Mark 3:20, 21 20 ¶ And He came home, and the crowd gathered again, to such an extent that they could not even eat a meal. 21 When His own people heard of this, they went out to take custody of Him; for they were saying, "He has lost His senses."

<u>John 7:5</u> For **not even His brothers were believing** in Him.

Matt. 12:48 But Jesus answered the one who was telling Him and said, "Who is My mother and who are My brothers?"

<u>John 8:24</u> "Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for unless you believe that I am *He*, you will die in your sins."

Matt. 12:49 And stretching out His hand toward His disciples, He said, "Behold My mother and My brothers!

Matt. 12:50 "For whoever does the will of My Father who is in heaven, he is My brother and sister and mother."

Mark 3:35 "For whoever does the will of God, he is My brother and sister and mother."

<u>Luke 8:21</u> But He answered and said to them, "My mother and My brothers are **these** who hear the word of God and do it."

<u>Matt. 7:21</u> ¶ "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven will enter.

Luke 11:27, 28 27 ¶ While Jesus was saying these things, one of the women in the crowd raised her voice and said to Him, "Blessed is the womb that bore You and the breasts at which You nursed." 28 But He said, "On the contrary, blessed are those who hear the word of God and observe it."

1 Cor. 15:7 then He appeared to James, then to all the apostles;

Gal. 1:19 But I did not see any other of the apostles except James, the Lord's brother.

<u>James 1:22</u> But prove yourselves doers of the word, and not merely hearers who delude themselves.

<u>John 6:40</u> "For this is **the will of My Father**, that everyone who **beholds the Son and believes in Him** will have **eternal life**, and I Myself **will raise him up** on the last day."

<u>John 6:27-29</u> "Do not work for the food which perishes, but for the food which endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give to you, for on Him the Father, God, has set His seal."

<u>28</u> Therefore they said to Him, "What shall we do, so that we may work the works of God?"

<u>29</u> Jesus answered and said to them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He has sent."

<u>John 14:21</u> "He who has My commandments **and keeps them** is the one who loves Me; and he who loves Me **will be loved by My Father**, and **I will love him** and will disclose Myself to him."
