1. The Travel Season was past now, v-9
2. Paul warns them that the trip was too dangerous, v-10; --Perfect Storm Movie, Cf. Rev. 20:13a
3. The Centurion Julius, is persuaded more by the Crew Leadership than Paul, v-11
4. The majority were not in favor of Paul's view, v-12, 13 --**a False Hope, -Phoenix**

G. Before Very Long They Knew They Had Made A Very Serious Mistake, v-14-20

H. Paul Reveals God's Plan For Them, v-21-26

1. He tells them they should have followed his advice, v-21
2. He seeks to encourage them with God's decision, that they all would survive, but will lose the ship, v-22
3. He tells them that the Source of his information was God, v-23-25
4. He reveals that they will be shipwrecked on a certain island, v-26
