

(Holman Charts, Maps, Reconstructions -Accordance Bible)

Malta (Meli÷th Meliteæ). An island in the Mediterranean, 60 miles south of Sicily. Controlled by Carthage from the 6th through the 2nd centuries BC, the Maltese spoke a form of Punic/Phoenician. This is why Luke refers to the Maltese as "barbarians" (Acts 27:2, 4), a term referring to those who spoke neither Greek nor Latin.

The apostle Paul was shipwrecked on Malta near the end of his prison voyage to Rome (around 59 AD) and stayed there for three months (Acts 27:27-28:11).

 - A. He Is Going To Rome As A Prisoner To Appear Before Caesar, v-1
 - 1. Luke is with him, v-1a
 - 2. Julius was in charge of the prisoners, v-1b
 - B. Aristarchus Was Traveling With Paul, v-2; Acts 19:29; Col. 4:10a
 - C. They Sail From Caesarea To Sidon Where He Is Allowed To See The Brethren, v-3
 - D. They Sail From Sidon To Myra And Board A Larger Ship, --Alexandrian, v-4-6
 - 1. They experience contrary winds, v-4,5
 - 2. The Imperial Grain ship was heading for Italy, v-6
 - E. The Journey From Myra Is Slow And Difficult Because Of The Winds, v-7, 8
 - F. Paul Attempts To Persuade The Crew To Winter At Fair Haven, v-9-13
 - 1. The Travel Season was past now, v-9
 - 2. Paul warns them that the trip was too dangerous, v-10; --Perfect Storm Movie, Cf. Rev. 20:13a
 - 3. The Centurion Julius, is persuaded more by the Crew Leadership than Paul, v-11
 - 4. The majority were not in favor of Paul's view, v-12, 13 --a False Hope, -Phoenix
