Sunday, June 20, 2021 Sermon Scriptures

<u>Luke 6:46</u> ¶ "Why do you call Me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say?

Ex. 3:13-15 13 ¶ Then Moses said to God, "Behold, I am going to the sons of Israel, and I will say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you.' Now they may say to me, 'What is His name?' What shall I say to them?" 14 God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM"; and He said, "Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you." 15 God, furthermore, said to Moses, "Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, 'The LORD, the God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you.' This is My name forever, and this is My memorial-name to all generations.

<u>John 8:56-59</u> <u>56</u> "Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, and he saw *it* and was glad." <u>57</u> So the Jews said to Him, "You are not yet fifty years old, and have You seen Abraham?" <u>58</u> Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I am." <u>59</u> Therefore they **picked up stones to throw at Him**, but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple.

Gen. 17:1 ¶ Now when Abram was ninety-nine years old, the LORD appeared to Abram and said to him, "I am God Almighty; Walk before Me, and be blameless.

<u>Gen. 14:18</u> And Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine; now he was a priest of **God Most High**.

<u>Gen. 21:33</u> *Abraham* planted a tamarisk tree at Beersheba, and there he called on the name of the LORD, **the Everlasting God**.

Gen. 22:14 Abraham called the name of that place The LORD Will Provide, as it is said to this day, "In the mount of the LORD it will be provided."

<u>Judg. 6:24</u> Then Gideon built an altar there to the LORD and named it **The LORD is Peace.** To this day it is still in Ophrah of the Abiezrites.

<u>1 Thess. 5:23</u> ¶ Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you entirely; and may your spirit and soul and body be preserved complete, without blame at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

<u>Heb. 1:1</u> \P God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways,

- <u>Heb. 1:2</u> in these last days has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world.
- Matt. 6:9 ¶ "Pray, then, in this way: 'Our Father who is in heaven, Hallowed be Your name.
- <u>Luke 11:2</u> And He said to them, "When you pray, say: 'Father, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come.
- Matt. 5:48 "Therefore you are to be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect.
- <u>1 Pet. 1:15, 16</u> but like the Holy One who called you, be holy yourselves also in all *your* behavior; <u>16</u> because it is written, "YOU SHALL BE HOLY, FOR I AM HOLY."
- <u>Matt. 6:14</u> "For if you forgive others for their transgressions, your **heavenly Father** will also forgive you.
- Matt. 6:25-33 25 ¶ "For this reason I say to you, do not be worried about your life, as to what you will eat or what you will drink; nor for your body, as to what you will put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? **26** "Look at the birds of the air, that they do not sow, nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not worth much more than they? **27** "And who of you by being worried can add a *single* hour to his life? 28 "And why are you worried about **clothing?** Observe how the lilies of the field grow; they do not toil nor do they spin, 29 yet I say to you that not even Solomon in all his glory clothed himself like one of **30** "But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which is *alive* today and these. tomorrow is thrown into the furnace, will He not much more clothe you? You of little 31 "Do not worry then, saying, 'What will we eat?' or 'What will we drink?' or faith! 'What will we wear for clothing?' 32 "For the Gentiles eagerly seek all these things; for **your heavenly Father** knows that you need all these things. **33** "But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.
- **Gal. 1:1** ¶ Paul, an apostle (not *sent* from men nor through the agency of man, but through Jesus Christ and **God the Father**, who raised Him from the dead),
- <u>1 Thess. 1:1</u> ¶ Paul and Silvanus and Timothy, ¶ To the **church of the Thessalonians** in **God the Father** and the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace to you and peace.
- **1 Cor. 1:3** ¶ Grace to you and peace **from God our Father** and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- **2 Cor. 1:2, 3 2** ¶ Grace to you and peace **from God our Father** and the Lord Jesus Christ.

- **<u>2 Cor. 1:3</u>** ¶ Blessed *be* **the God and Father** of our Lord Jesus Christ, **the Father** of mercies and God of all comfort,
- **Eph. 1:2** Grace to you and peace from **God our Father** and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- <u>Col. 1:1, 2</u> ¶ Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, and Timothy our brother, 2 ¶ To the saints and faithful brethren in Christ *who are* at Colossae: Grace to you and peace **from God our Father**.
- <u>1 John 3:1-3</u> ¶ See how great a love **the Father** has bestowed on us, that we would be **called children of God; and** *such* **we are**. For this reason the world does not know us, because it did not know Him. <u>2</u> Beloved, **now we are children of God**, and it has not appeared as yet what we will be. We know that when He appears, we will be like Him, because we will see Him just as He is. <u>3</u> And everyone **who has this hope** *fixed* **on Him purifies himself, just as He is pure.**
- <u>Luke 15:17-19</u> "But when he came to his senses, he said, 'How many of my father's **hired men have more than enough** bread, but I am dying here with hunger!

 18 'I will get up and go to my father, and will say to him, "Father, I have sinned against heaven, and in your sight;

 19 I am no longer worthy to be called your son; make me as one of your hired men."
- Matt. 7:11 "If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give what is good to those who ask Him!
- <u>Luke 11:11</u> "Now suppose **one of you fathers** is asked by his son for a fish; he will not give him a snake instead of a fish, will he?
- <u>Heb. 12:5-7 5</u> and you have forgotten the exhortation which is addressed to you as sons, "MY SON, DO NOT REGARD LIGHTLY THE DISCIPLINE OF THE LORD, NOR FAINT WHEN YOU ARE REPROVED BY HIM; <u>6</u> FOR THOSE WHOM THE LORD LOVES HE DISCIPLINES, AND HE SCOURGES EVERY SON WHOM HE RECEIVES." <u>7</u> It is for discipline that you endure; God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there **whom** *his* **father does not discipline**?
- <u>Prov. 3:12</u> For whom the LORD loves He reproves, **Even as a father** *corrects* the son in whom he delights.
- **Eph. 6:4** ¶ **Fathers**, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.
