Sunday, June 27, 2021 Sermon Scriptures

Eph. 3:2-5 2 if indeed you have heard of **the stewardship of God's grace** which was given to me for you; **3** that **by revelation** there was **made known to me the mystery**, as I wrote before in brief. **4** By referring to this, when you read you can understand my insight into **the mystery of Christ**, **5** which in other generations **was not made known** to the sons of men, as it has **now been revealed** to His holy apostles and prophets in the Spirit;

Eph. 3:9 and to bring to light what is the **administration of the mystery** which **for ages has been hidden in God** who created all things;

<u>Eph. 3:6, 7</u> 6 to be specific, that the Gentiles are fellow heirs and fellow members of the body, and fellow partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel, <u>7</u> of which I was made a minister, according to the gift of God's grace which was given to me according to the working of His power.

Eph. 3:10, 11 10 so that the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known through the church to the rulers and the authorities in the heavenly *places*. **11** *This was* in accordance with the eternal purpose which He carried out in Christ Jesus our Lord,

Eph. 1:3-6 3 ¶ Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly *places* in Christ,

<u>4</u> just as **He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world**, that we **would be holy and blameless** before Him. In love

Eph. 5:25-27 25 ¶ Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her, 26 so that He might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, 27 that He might present to Himself the church in all her glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she would be holy and blameless.

Eph. 1:5 He **predestined us to adoption as sons** through Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the kind intention of His will,

<u>6</u> to the **praise of the glory of His grace**, which He freely bestowed on us in the Beloved.

<u>1 Tim. 2:5</u> For there is one God, and one mediator also between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,

<u>John 14:6</u> Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

<u>Gal. 2:16</u> nevertheless knowing that **a man is not justified by the works** of the Law but through faith in Christ Jesus, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, so that we may be justified by faith in Christ and **not by the works of the Law**; since **by the works of the Law no flesh will be justified**.

<u>Rom. 4:6</u> just as David also speaks of the blessing on the man to whom **God credits** righteousness apart from works

Eph. 2:10 For **we are His workmanship**, created in Christ Jesus **for good works**, which **God prepared beforehand** so that **we would walk in them.**

<u>Rom. 2:5-7</u> <u>5</u> But because of your stubbornness and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself **in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God, <u>6</u> who WILL RENDER TO EACH PERSON ACCORDING TO HIS DEEDS: <u>7</u> to those who by perseverance in doing good** seek for glory and honor and immortality, **eternal life**;

<u>Titus 3:8</u> This is a trustworthy statement; and concerning these things I want you to speak confidently, so that **those who have believed God will be careful to engage in good deeds.** These things are good and profitable for men.

<u>2 Tim. 1:9</u> who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, **not according to our works**, but according to His own purpose and grace which was granted us in Christ Jesus **from all eternity**,

Eph. 2:5, 8, 9 5 even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (**by grace you have been saved**),

8 For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; **9** not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.

<u>John 1:17</u> For the Law was given through Moses; grace and truth were realized through Jesus Christ.

<u>Titus 3:5</u> He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration **and renewing by the Holy Spirit,**

<u>John 3:3, 5</u> Jesus answered and said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God."

- <u>John 3:5</u> Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water **and** the Spirit he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.
- <u>1 Pet. 1:23</u> for you have **been born again** not of seed which is perishable but imperishable, *that is*, through the living and enduring word of God.
- <u>2 Cor. 1:22</u> who also sealed us and gave us the Spirit in our hearts as a pledge.
- **Eph. 4:30** Do not grieve the **Holy Spirit** of God, **by whom you were sealed** for the day of redemption.
- **Eph. 1:13** In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation having also believed, **you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise,**
- <u>Rom. 8:23</u> And not only this, but also we ourselves, having the first fruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting eagerly for *our* adoption as sons, the redemption of our body.
