Job 13:15 Though He slay me, yet will I trust Him. Even so, I will defend my own ways before Him. (*NKJV*)

<u>Psa. 31:1</u> ¶ In You, O LORD, **I put my trust**; Let me never be ashamed; Deliver me in Your righteousness. (*NKJV*)

<u>Psa. 32:10</u> Many are the sorrows of the wicked, But **he who trusts in the LORD**, lovingkindness shall surround him.

Psa. 37:5 Commit your way to the LORD, **Trust also in Him**, and He will do it.

<u>Psa. 71:5</u> For You are my hope, O Lord GOD; *You are* my trust from my youth. (*NKJV*)

Prov. 3:5, 65Trust in the LORD with all your heartAnd do not lean on yourown understanding. $\underline{6}$ In all your ways acknowledge Him,And He will makeyour paths straight.

Isa. 26:3, 43"The steadfast of mind You will keep in perfect peace, Because hetrusts in You. $\underline{4}$ "Trust in the LORD forever, For in GOD the LORD, we havean everlasting Rock.

<u>Jer. 17:7</u> "Blessed is the man who trusts in the LORD And whose trust is the LORD.

<u>Nah. 1:7</u> The LORD *is* good, A stronghold in the day of trouble; And He knows those who trust in Him.

<u>**2** Cor. 1:9, 10</u> <u>9</u> Yes, we had the sentence of death in ourselves, that we **should not trust in ourselves but in God** who raises the dead, <u>10</u> who delivered us from so great a death, and does deliver us; **in whom we trust** that He will still deliver *us*, (*NKJV*)

<u>2 Tim. 1:8-12</u> <u>8</u> Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord or of me His prisoner, but join with *me* in suffering for the gospel according to the power of God, <u>9</u> who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was **granted us in Christ Jesus from all eternity**, <u>10</u> but now has been revealed by the appearing of our Savior Christ Jesus, who abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel, <u>11</u> for which I was appointed a preacher and an apostle and a teacher.

<u>2 Tim. 1:12</u> For this reason I also suffer these things, but I am not ashamed; for I know whom I have believed and I am convinced that He is able to guard what I have entrusted to Him until that day.

<u>John 3:16-18</u> <u>16</u> "For God so loved the world, that **He gave His only begotten** Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life. <u>17</u> "For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him. <u>18</u> "He who believes in Him is not judged; he who does not believe has been judged already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

<u>Acts 4:12</u> "And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved."

<u>Psa. 119:42</u> So I will have an answer for him who reproaches me, For I trust in Your word.

John 17:17 "Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth.

Rom. 12:1, 2 1 ¶ Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, *which is* your spiritual service of worship. 2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

Phil. 1:21 For to me, **to live is Christ** and to die is gain.

Gal. 5:22-2522But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness,
goodness, faithfulness,23gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.24Now those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions
and desires.25 ¶ If we live by the Spirit, let us also walk by the Spirit.

<u>2 Cor. 5:8</u> we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather to be absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord.

<u>1 Thess. 4:13, 14</u> <u>13</u> \P But we do not want you to be uninformed, brethren, about **those who are asleep**, so that you will not grieve as do the rest who have no hope. <u>14</u> For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, **even so God will bring with Him those who have fallen asleep in Jesus.** **<u>Phil. 4:19</u>** And my **God will supply all your needs** according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

<u>Heb. 13:5</u> *Make sure that* your character is free from the love of money, being content with what you have; for He Himself has said, "I WILL NEVER DESERT YOU, NOR WILL I EVER FORSAKE YOU,"

<u>**1** Tim. 6:9</u> But those who want to get rich fall into temptation and a snare and many foolish and harmful desires which plunge men into ruin and destruction.

James 1:13, 14 13 Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am being tempted by God"; for **God cannot be tempted by evil**, and **He Himself does not tempt anyone**. <u>14</u> But each one is **tempted when he is carried away and enticed by his own lust.**

<u>Rom. 13:14</u> But **put on the Lord Jesus Christ**, and **make no provision for the flesh** in regard to *its* lusts.

<u>1 Cor. 10:13</u> No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and **God** is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, so that you will be able to endure it.

Rom. 6:11-1411Even so consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God in
Christ Jesus.12Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you
obey its lusts,13and do not go on presenting the members of your body to
sin as instruments of unrighteousness; but present yourselves to God as those alive
from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.14For sin
shall not be master over you, for you are not under law but under grace.
