

Country of the Gadarenes

Gadara was one of the ten cities of the Decapolis, located to the southeast of the Sea of Galilee near the Yarmuk River. The modern name of the city is Umm Qais.

The region of the Gadarenes is mentioned in connection with the healing of the demoniac and the drowning of the swine in the Sea of Galilee (Matthew 8:28; Mark 5:1; Luke 8:26, 37), depending on the Greek manuscript or translation, but the city of Gadara itself is too far from the sea to be the actual location of this event. Based on geographical descriptions in the gospels, it is probable that this miracle took place at Gergesa, and that the reference to the Gadarenes is meant to be taken as a general designation for this region.
