<u>Mark 1:34</u> And He healed many who were ill with various diseases, and cast out many demons; and He was not permitting the demons to speak, because they knew who He was.

<u>Mark 1:39</u> And He went into their synagogues throughout all Galilee, preaching **and casting out the demons.**

Matt. 9:34 But the Pharisees were saying, "He casts out the demons by the ruler of the demons."

Matt. 12:24, 27, 28 24 But when the Pharisees heard *this*, they said, "This man casts out demons only by Beelzebul the ruler of the demons."

<u>27</u> "If I by Beelzebul cast out demons, by whom do your sons cast *them* out? For this reason they will be your judges. <u>28</u> "But if I cast out demons by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God has come upon you.

Matt. 8:28a ¶ When He came to the other side into the country of the Gadarenes, two men who were demon-possessed met Him as they were coming out of the tombs. *They were* so extremely violent that no one could pass by that way.

<u>Mark 5:3-5</u> <u>3</u> and he had his dwelling among the tombs. And no one was able to bind him anymore, even with a chain; <u>4</u> because **he had often been bound with shackles and chains**, and the chains **had been torn apart by him** and the **shackles broken in pieces**, and no one was strong enough to subdue him. <u>5</u> Constantly, night and day, he was **screaming among the tombs and in the mountains**, and **gashing himself** with stones.

<u>Luke 8:27</u> And when He came out onto the land, He was met by a man from the city who was possessed with demons; and **who had not put on any clothing for a long time**, and was not living in a house, but in the tombs.

<u>Matt. 8:29</u> And they cried out, saying, "What business do we have with each other, **Son of God?** Have You come here to torment us before the time?"

<u>Luke 8:28</u> Seeing Jesus, he cried out and fell before Him, and said in a loud voice, "What business do we have with each other, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I beg You, do not torment me."

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<u>Matt. 8:29c</u> And they cried out, saying, "What business do we have with each other, Son of God? Have You come here to torment us before the time?"

Luke 8:28b Seeing Jesus, he cried out and fell before Him, and said in a loud voice, "What business do we have with each other, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? **I beg You, do not torment me."**

<u>Mark 5:8</u> For He had been saying to him, "Come out of the man, you unclean spirit!"

<u>Luke 8:29a</u> For He had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. . . .

<u>Mark 5:9</u> And He was asking him, "What is your name?" And he said to Him, "My name is Legion; for we are many."

<u>Mark 5:10</u> And he *began* to implore Him earnestly **not to send them out of the country**.

<u>Luke 8:31</u> They were imploring Him not to command them to go away into the abyss.

Matt. 8:30, 3130Now there was a herd of many swine feeding at adistance from them.31The demons began to entreat Him, saying, "If Youare going to cast us out, send us into the herd of swine."

Matt. 8:32a And He said to them, "Go!"

<u>Matt. 8:32b...</u> And they came out and **went into the swine**, and the **whole herd rushed down the steep bank into the sea** and perished in the waters.

<u>Mark 5:13</u> Jesus gave them permission. And coming out, the unclean spirits entered the swine; and the herd rushed down the steep bank into the sea, **about two thousand** *of them;* and they were **drowned in the sea**.

<u>Matt. 8:33</u> The herdsmen ran away, and went to the city and reported everything, including what had happened to the demoniacs.

<u>Luke 8:34</u> \P When the herdsmen saw what had happened, they ran away and reported it in the city and *out* in the country.

Luke 8:35, 36 35 The people went out to see what had happened; and they came to Jesus, and found the man from whom the demons had gone out, sitting down at the feet of Jesus, clothed and in his right mind; and they became frightened. <u>36</u> Those who had seen it reported to them how the man who was demon-possessed had been made well.

<u>Matt. 8:34</u> And behold, the whole city came out to meet Jesus; and when they saw Him, they implored Him to leave their region.

<u>Luke 8:37</u> And all the people of the country of the Gerasenes and the surrounding district **asked Him to leave them**, for **they were gripped with great fear**; and He got into a boat and returned.

<u>Mark 5:18</u> As He was getting into the boat, **the man** who had been demonpossessed **was imploring Him that he might accompany Him.**

<u>Mark 5:19</u> And He did not let him, but He said to him, "Go home to your people and report to them what great things the Lord has done for you, and *how* He had mercy on you."

<u>Mark 5:20</u> And he went away and **began to proclaim in Decapolis what** great things Jesus had done for him; and everyone was amazed.
