<u>Eph. 5:1</u> ¶ Therefore **be imitators of God**, as beloved children;

1 Pet. 1:15, 1615but like the Holy One who called you, be holy yourselves also inall your behavior;16because it is written, "YOU SHALL BE HOLY, FOR I AMHOLY."

<u>Eph. 5:2</u> and walk in love, just as Christ also loved you and gave Himself up for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God as a fragrant aroma.

John 10:11, 1711¶ "I am the good shepherd; the good shepherd lays down His life
for the sheep.for the sheep. $\underline{17}$ "For this reason the Father loves Me, because I lay down
My life so that I may take it again.

<u>2 Cor. 2:15, 16</u> 15 For we are a fragrance of Christ to God among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing; <u>16</u> to the one an aroma from death to death, to the other an aroma from life to life. And who is adequate for these things?

<u>Phil. 4:18</u> But I have received everything in full and have an abundance; I am amply supplied, having received from Epaphroditus what you have sent, a fragrant aroma, an acceptable sacrifice, well-pleasing to God.

Eph. 5:3 ¶ But **immorality or any impurity or greed** must not even be named among you, as is proper among **saints**;

<u>Rom. 1:7</u> ¶ to all who are beloved of God in Rome, **called** *as* **saints**: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

<u>**1** Cor. 1:2</u> ¶ To the church of God which is at Corinth, to those **who have been sanctified** in Christ Jesus, **saints by calling**, with all who in every place call on the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, their *Lord* and ours:

Eph. 5:4 and *there must be no* **filthiness and silly talk, or coarse jesting**, which are not fitting, but **rather giving of thanks.**

<u>Col. 3:15, 16</u> <u>15</u> Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body; **and be thankful**. <u>16</u> Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms *and* hymns *and* spiritual songs, **singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God**.

Eph. 5:5-7 5 For this **you know with certainty**, that **no immoral or impure person or covetous man**, who is an idolater, has an inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God. <u>6</u> \P Let **no one deceive you** with empty words, for **because of these things** the **wrath of God comes** upon the **sons of disobedience**. <u>7</u> Therefore do not be partakers with them;

<u>**1** Cor. 6:9-11</u> <u>9</u> ¶ Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived; neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor homosexuals, <u>10</u> nor thieves, nor *the* covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers, will inherit the kingdom of God. <u>11</u> Such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God.

<u>Eph. 5:8</u> for you were **formerly darkness**, but **now you are Light in the Lord**; walk as children of Light

<u>John 8:12</u> ¶ Then Jesus again spoke to them, saying, "I am the Light of the world; he who follows Me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the Light of life."

<u>Col. 1:13</u> For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son,

Eph. 5:9, 109(for the fruit of the Light consists in all goodness and righteousness and truth),and truth),10 trying to learn what is pleasing to the Lord.

<u>Rom. 12:2</u> And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

<u>Eph. 5:11</u> Do not participate in the unfruitful deeds of darkness, but instead even expose them;

<u>Eph. 5:12</u> for it is **disgraceful even to speak of** the things which are done by them **in** secret.
