Mark 5:22-2422One of the synagogue officials named Jairus came up, and onseeing Him, fell at His feet23 and implored Him earnestly, saying, "My littledaughter is at the point of death; *please* come and lay Your hands on her, so that she willget well and live."24And He went off with him; and a large crowd was followingHim and pressing in on Him.

<u>Luke 8:49</u> ¶ While He was still speaking, someone came from *the house of* the synagogue official, saying, "Your daughter has died; do not trouble the Teacher anymore."

<u>Luke 8:50</u> But when Jesus heard *this*, He answered him, "Do not be afraid *any longer*; only believe, and she will be made well."

<u>Luke 8:51</u> When He came to the house, He did not allow anyone to enter with Him, except Peter and John and James, and the girl's father and mother.

<u>Mark 5:38</u> They came to the house of the synagogue official; and **He saw a** commotion, and *people* loudly weeping and wailing.

<u>Matt. 9:23</u> \P When Jesus came into the official's house, and saw **the flute-players** and the crowd **in noisy disorder**,

<u>Mark 5:39</u> And entering in, He said to them, "Why make a commotion and weep? The child has not died, **but is asleep.**"

John 11:11-15 11 This He said, and after that He said to them, "Our friend Lazarus has fallen asleep; but I go, so that I may awaken him out of sleep." <u>12</u> The disciples then said to Him, "Lord, if he has fallen asleep, he will recover." <u>13</u> Now Jesus had spoken of his death, but they thought that He was speaking of literal sleep. <u>14</u> So Jesus then said to them plainly, "Lazarus is dead, <u>15</u> and I am glad for your sakes that I was not there, so that you may believe; but let us go to him."

Luke 8:53 And they began laughing at Him, knowing that she had died.

<u>Mark 5:40b</u> They *began* laughing at Him. **But putting them all out,** He took along the child's father and mother and His own companions, and entered *the room* where the child was.

Luke 8:54 He, however, took her by the hand and called, saying, "Child, arise!"

<u>Mark 5:41</u> Taking the child by the hand, He said to her, "Talitha kum!" (which translated means, "Little girl, I say to you, get up!").

<u>Luke 8:55a</u> And her spirit returned, and she got up immediately; and He gave orders for *something* to be given her to eat.

<u>Mark 5:42</u> Immediately the girl got up and *began* to walk, for she was twelve years old. And immediately they were completely astounded.

<u>Luke 8:55b</u> And her spirit returned, and she got up immediately; and **He gave orders for** *something* to be given her to eat.

<u>Mark 5:43</u> And He gave them strict orders that no one should know about this, and He said that *something* should be given her to eat.

<u>Luke 8:56</u> Her parents were amazed; but **He instructed them to tell no one what had** happened.

Matt. 9:26 This news spread throughout all that land.

Mark 1:40-4540 \P And a leper came to Jesus, beseeching Him and falling on his
knees before Him, and saying, "If You are willing, You can make me clean."41Moved with compassion, Jesus stretched out His hand and touched him, and said to
him, "I am willing; be cleansed."4242Immediately the leprosy left him and he was
cleansed.4344and He sternly warned him and immediately sent him away,
priest and offer for your cleansing what Moses commanded, as a testimony to them."
