<u>Eph. 5:22</u> ¶ Wives, *be subject* to your own husbands, as to the Lord.

Eph. 5:21 and be **subject to one another** in the **fear of Christ**.

<u>1 Pet. 3:1-6</u> In the same way, **you wives, be submissive to your own husbands** so that **even if any** *of them* **are disobedient** to the word, they may be won without a word by the behavior of their wives, <u>2</u> as they **observe your chaste and respectful behavior**. <u>3 Your adornment must not be *merely* **external** — braiding the hair, and wearing gold jewelry, or putting on dresses; <u>4</u> but *let it be* **the hidden person of the heart**, with the imperishable **quality of a gentle and quiet spirit**, which is **precious in the sight of God**. <u>5</u> For in this way **in former times the holy women** also, **who hoped in God, used to adorn themselves**, being **submissive** to their own husbands; <u>6</u> just as Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him lord, and you have become her children if you do what is right without being frightened by any fear.</u>

Eph. 5:23 For the **husband is the head of the wife**, as **Christ** also is the **head of the church**, He Himself *being* the **Savior of the body**.

Eph. 5:24 But as the church is subject to Christ, so also the wives *ought to be* to their husbands in everything.

<u>Eph. 5:25</u> ¶ Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her,

Eph. 5:26, 27 26 so that He might **sanctify her**, **having cleansed her** by the washing of water with the word, **27 that He might present to Himself** the church in all **her glory**, having **no spot or wrinkle or any such thing**; but that she would be **holy and blameless**.

Eph. 5:28, 29a 28 So **husbands** ought also to love their own wives **as their own bodies.** He who loves his own wife **loves himself**; **29** for no one ever hated his own flesh, **but nourishes and cherishes it**, just as **Christ also** *does* **the church**,

Eph. 5:30 because we are members of His body.

Eph. 5:31 FOR THIS REASON A MAN SHALL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND MOTHER AND SHALL BE **JOINED TO HIS WIFE**, AND THE **TWO SHALL BECOME ONE FLESH.**

<u>Gen. 2:24</u> For this reason a man shall leave his father and his mother, and **be joined to** his wife; and they shall become one flesh.

<u>Matt. 19:4, 5</u> <u>4</u> And He answered and said, "Have you not read that He who created *them* from the beginning MADE THEM MALE AND FEMALE,

<u>5</u> and said, 'FOR THIS REASON A MAN SHALL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND MOTHER AND BE JOINED TO HIS WIFE, AND **THE TWO SHALL BECOME ONE FLESH'**?

Eph. 5:32 This mystery is great; but I am speaking with reference to Christ and the church.

Eph. 5:33 Nevertheless, **each individual among you** also is to **love his own wife** even as himself, and **the wife must** *see to it* that she **respects her husband**.
