Sermon Scriptures

Rom. 10:1 ¶ Brethren, my **heart's desire and my prayer to God** for them is for *their* salvation.

=====

Rom. 10:2 For I testify about them that they have **a zeal for God**, but **not in accordance with knowledge**.

=====

Rom. 10:3 For not knowing about God's righteousness and seeking to establish their own, they did not subject themselves to the righteousness of God.

Rom. 9:31, 32 **31** but Israel, pursuing **a law of righteousness**, did not arrive at *that* law. **32** Why? Because *they did not pursue it* by faith, but as though *it were* by works. **They stumbled over the stumbling stone**,

Rom. 9:33 just as it is written, "BEHOLD, I LAY IN ZION A STONE OF STUMBLING AND A ROCK OF OFFENSE, AND HE WHO BELIEVES IN HIM WILL NOT BE DISAPPOINTED."

=====

Rom. 10:4 For **Christ is the end of the law for righteousness** to everyone who believes.

=====

Rom. 10:5 ¶ For Moses writes that the man who practices the righteousness which is based on law **shall live by that righteousness**.

Gal. 3:10 ¶ For as many as are of the works of the Law are under a curse; for it is written, "CURSED IS EVERYONE WHO **DOES NOT ABIDE BY ALL THINGS WRITTEN IN THE BOOK OF THE LAW, TO PERFORM THEM**."

James 2:10 For whoever keeps the whole law and **yet stumbles in one point, he has become guilty of all**.

=====

Rom. 10:6 But the **righteousness based on faith** speaks as follows: "DO NOT SAY IN YOUR HEART, 'WHO WILL ASCEND INTO HEAVEN?' (that is, to bring Christ down),

Rom. 10:7 or 'WHO WILL DESCEND INTO THE ABYSS?' (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead)."

Rom. 10:8 But what does it say? "**THE WORD IS NEAR YOU, IN YOUR MOUTH AND IN YOUR HEART**" — that is, the word of faith which we are preaching,

Rom. 10:9, 10 9 that if you **confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord**, and **believe in your heart** that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; 10 for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation.

=====

Rom. 10:11 For the Scripture says, “**WHOEVER BELIEVES IN HIM WILL NOT BE DISAPPOINTED.**”

Rom. 9:33b just as it is written, “**BEHOLD, I LAY IN ZION A STONE OF STUMBLING AND A ROCK OF OFFENSE, AND HE WHO BELIEVES IN HIM WILL NOT BE DISAPPOINTED.**”

=====

Rom. 10:12 For there is **no distinction between Jew and Greek**; for the same *Lord* is Lord of all, **abounding in riches** for all who call on Him;

Rom. 1:16 ¶ For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

=====

Rom. 10:13 for “**WHOEVER WILL CALL ON THE NAME OF THE LORD WILL BE SAVED.**”

=====

Rom. 10:14 ¶ How then will they **call on Him** in whom they have not believed? How will they **believe in Him** whom they **have not heard**? And how will they **hear without a preacher**?

Rom. 10:15 How will they **preach unless they are sent**? Just as it is written, “**HOW BEAUTIFUL ARE THE FEET OF THOSE WHO BRING GOOD NEWS OF GOOD THINGS!**”

Is. 52:7 ¶ How lovely on the mountains **Are the feet of him who brings good news**, Who announces peace And brings good news of happiness, Who announces salvation, And says to Zion, “Your God reigns!”

Acts 1:8 but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and **you shall be My witnesses** both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth.”

Luke 24:46-48 46 and He said to them, “Thus it is written, that **the Christ would suffer and rise again from the dead the third day**, 47 and that **repentance for forgiveness of sins** would be proclaimed in His name **to all the nations**, beginning from Jerusalem. 48 “**You are witnesses of these things.**

Matt. 28:19 “Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit,

Rom. 10:16 ¶ However, they did not all heed the good news; for Isaiah says, “**LORD, WHO HAS BELIEVED OUR REPORT?**”

Isa. 53:1 ¶ Who has believed our message? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?

John 12:37-41 **37** But though He had performed so many signs before them, yet they were not believing in Him. **38** This was to fulfill the word of Isaiah the prophet which he spoke: “LORD, WHO HAS BELIEVED OUR REPORT? AND TO WHOM HAS THE ARM OF THE LORD BEEN REVEALED?” **39** For this reason they could not believe, for Isaiah said again, **40** “HE HAS BLINDED THEIR EYES AND HE HARDENED THEIR HEART, SO THAT THEY WOULD NOT SEE WITH THEIR EYES AND PERCEIVE WITH THEIR HEART, AND BE CONVERTED AND I HEAL THEM.” **41** These things Isaiah said because he saw His glory, and he spoke of Him.

=====

Rom. 10:17 So faith *comes* from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.

=====

Rom. 10:18 ¶ But I say, surely they have never heard, have they? Indeed they have; “THEIR VOICE HAS GONE OUT INTO ALL THE EARTH, AND THEIR WORDS TO THE ENDS OF THE WORLD.”

Rom. 10:19 But I say, surely Israel did not know, did they? First Moses says, “I WILL MAKE YOU JEALOUS BY THAT WHICH IS NOT A NATION, BY A NATION WITHOUT UNDERSTANDING WILL I ANGER YOU.”

Psa. 19:1-4 **1** ¶ The heavens are telling of the glory of God; And their expanse is declaring the work of His hands. **2** Day to day pours forth speech, And night to night reveals knowledge. **3** There is no speech, nor are there words; Their voice is not heard. **4** Their line has gone out through all the earth, And their utterances to the end of the world. In them He has placed a tent for the sun,

=====

Rom. 10:19 But I say, surely Israel did not know, did they? First Moses says, “I WILL MAKE YOU JEALOUS BY THAT WHICH IS NOT A NATION, BY A NATION WITHOUT UNDERSTANDING WILL I ANGER YOU.”

Deut. 32:21 ‘They have made Me jealous with *what* is not God; They have provoked Me to anger with their idols. So I will make them jealous with *those who* are not a people; I will provoke them to anger with a foolish nation,

Rom. 10:20 And **Isaiah is very bold and says**, “I WAS FOUND BY THOSE WHO DID NOT SEEK ME, I BECAME MANIFEST TO THOSE WHO DID NOT ASK FOR ME.”

=====

Isa. 65:1, 2 ¶ “**I permitted Myself to be sought by those who did not ask *for Me***; I permitted Myself to be found by those who did not seek Me. I said, ‘Here am I, here am I,’ To a nation which did not call on My name.

2 “I have spread out My hands all day long to **a rebellious people**, Who walk *in* the way which is not good, **following their own thoughts**,

Rom. 10:21 But as for Israel He says, “ALL THE DAY LONG I HAVE STRETCHED OUT MY HANDS TO A **DISOBEDIENT AND OBSTINATE PEOPLE**.”
