B. Early Human History

1. Cain kills Righteous Abel, Gen. 4:8;
Heb. 11:4; 1 Jn. 3:12 (first Murder)

Cf. Acts 2:22, 23,32, 36, -The **Redeemer**
would be killed by His People.

2. Civilization begins to take place

- a. Cain builds a city, Gen. 4:17

- b. Culture begins to appear,
Gen. 4:21, 22

3. Parts of the Race begins to manifest its
rejection of God, Rom. 1:18-25

4. Many in the Race followed God and
worshipped Him

- a. Seth, Gen. 4:26 (912 yrs.)

- Cf. Christ -Lk. 3:23, 24,38

- b. Enoch Gen. 5:24; Heb. 11:5;
-A Prophet, Jude 14

- c. Methuselah, Gen. 5:27 (969 yrs.)

--2 or 3 thousands of years cover this period (?)

C. Mankind's Sin Becomes Great!

1. The Sons of God marry the Daughters of
Men, Gen. 6:1,4

--The godly line is compromised!

2. The Greatness of Mankind's sin greatly
grieves God, Gen. 6:5-10

3. God destroys Mankind with the Genesis
Flood Judgment, Gen. 6:11-13; 7:1, 4, 10-12
17-24

--The Need for the Redeemer to come.
Cf. Lk. 2:10-14 --He Came!
