1 Thess. 4:13-1813 \P But we do not want you to be uninformed, brethren, aboutthose who are asleep, so that you will not grieve as do the rest who have no hope.14For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Himthose who have fallen asleep in Jesus.15For this we say to you by the word of theLord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord, will notprecede those who have fallen asleep.

<u>1 Thess. 4:16</u> For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of *the* archangel and with the trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. <u>17</u> Then we who are alive and remain will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we shall always be with the Lord. <u>18</u> Therefore comfort one another with these words.

<u>1 Cor. 15:51-53</u> <u>51</u> Behold, **I tell you a mystery; we will not all sleep**, but we will all be changed, <u>52</u> in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet; for the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed. <u>53</u> For this perishable must put on the imperishable, and this mortal must put on immortality.

Phil. 3:20, 21 20 For **our citizenship is in heaven**, from which also we eagerly wait for a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ; **21** who will transform the body of our humble state into conformity with the body of His glory, by the exertion of the power that He has even to subject all things to Himself.

<u>Matt. 7:21</u> ¶ "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven *will enter*.

Luke 6:46 ¶ "Why do you call Me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say?

John 3:7 "Do not be amazed that I said to you, 'You must be born again.'

<u>2 Tim. 2:19</u> Nevertheless, **the firm foundation of God stands**, having this seal, "**The Lord knows those who are His**," and, "Everyone who names the name of the Lord is to abstain from wickedness."

<u>Matt. 24:30</u> "And then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in the sky, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the SON OF MAN COMING ON THE CLOUDS OF THE SKY with power and great glory.

<u>Matt. 24:36</u> ¶ "But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but the Father alone.

<u>Rom. 12:1, 2</u> ¶ Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, **to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God**, *which is* your spiritual service of worship. <u>2</u> And **do not be conformed to this world**, but be transformed **by the renewing of your mind**, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

Rom. 6:11-1311Even so consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to Godin Christ Jesus.12 ¶ Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that youobey its lusts,13 and do not go on presenting the members of your body to sin asinstruments of unrighteousness; but present yourselves to God as those alive from thedead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.

<u>Phil. 1:20, 21</u> <u>20</u> according to **my earnest expectation and hope**, that I will not be put to shame in anything, but *that* with all boldness, **Christ will even now, as always**, be **exalted in my body**, whether by life or by death. <u>21</u> For to me, **to live is Christ and to die is gain**.

<u>John 13:34, 35</u> <u>34</u> "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another. <u>35</u> "By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

<u>**1** John 3:23</u> ¶ This is **His commandment**, that we **believe in the name of His Son Jesus Chris**t, and love one another, **just as He commanded us.**
